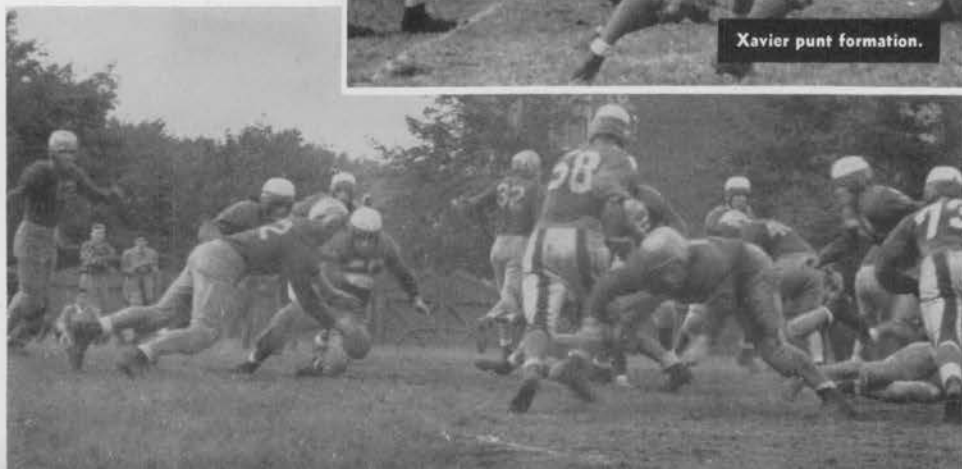
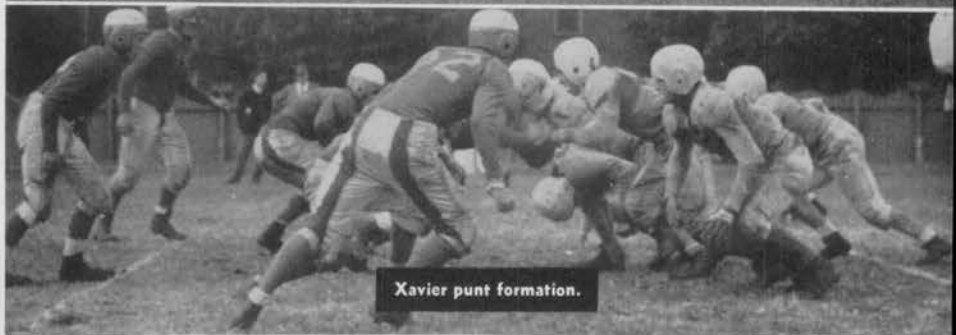
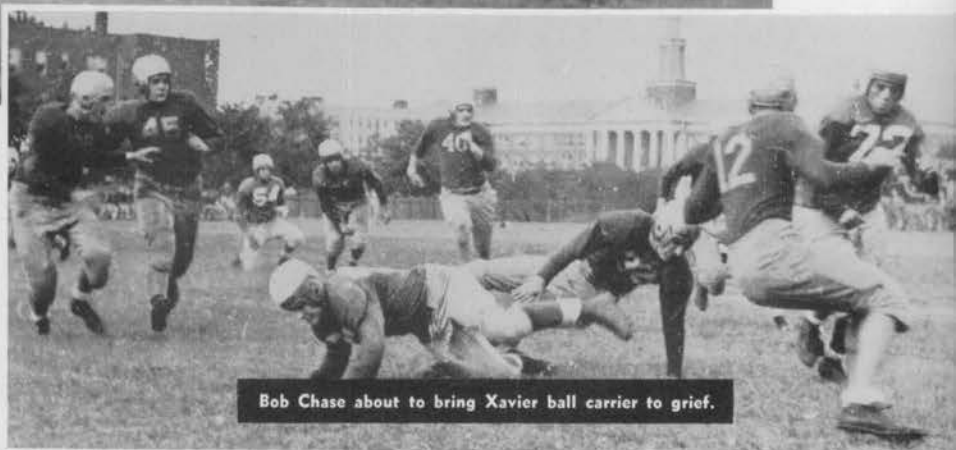


### PREP 7—XAVIER 7

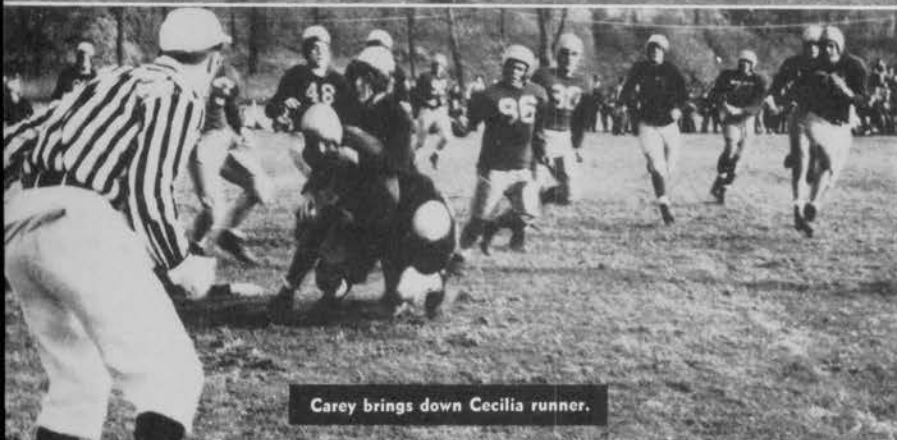

# Baseball



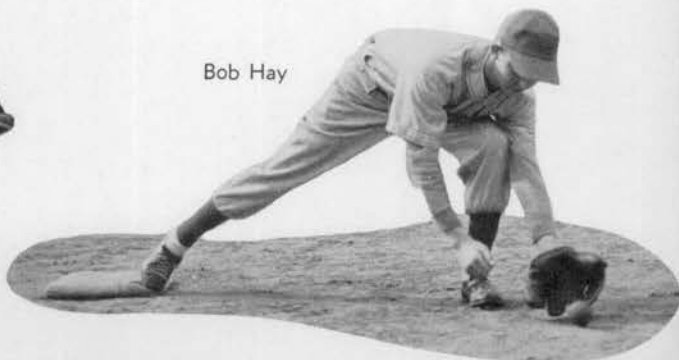

COACH WALTER DOOLAN'S swimming team enjoyed a successful season last winter. Led by Captain Bob Curran, the team showed a final 14-4 record, placed fourth in the Catholic Championships, third in the Private School Championships, and second in the Jesuit Championships, coming within three points of upsetting mighty Fordham.

High scorer of the team was Tom O'Connor, Captain-elect, who swam the 100 yard freestyle and anchored the medley relay. 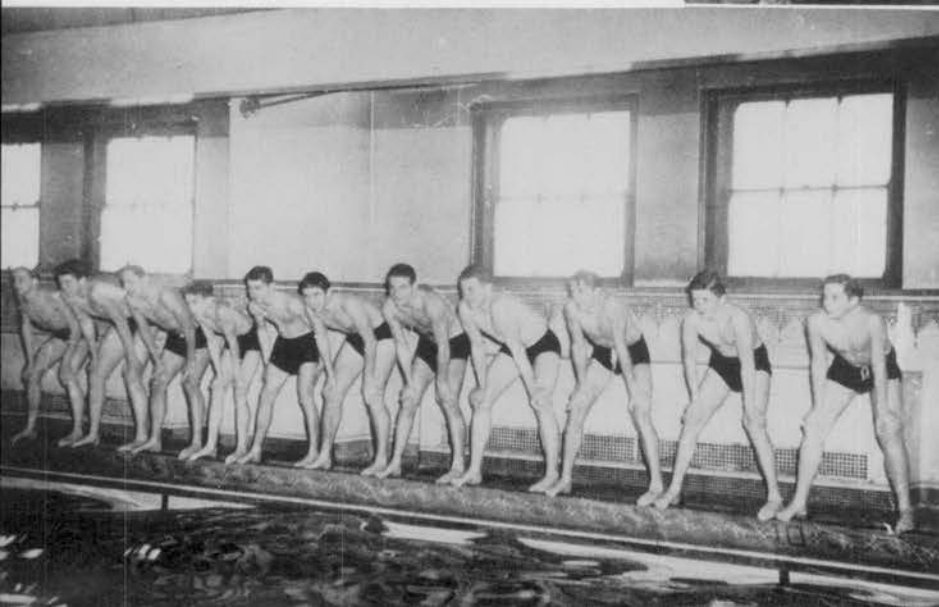

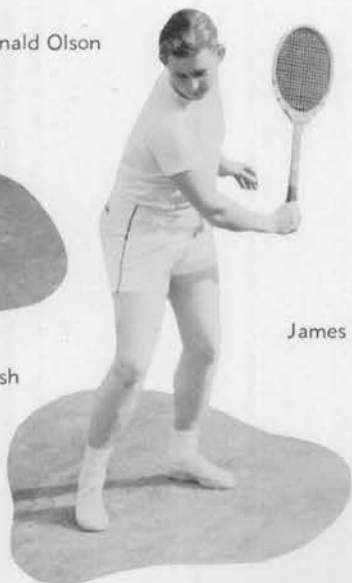

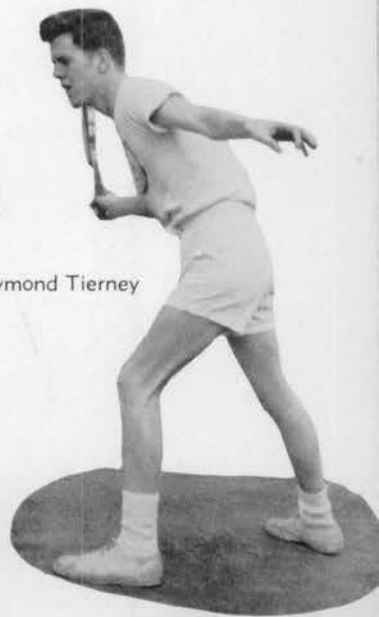
