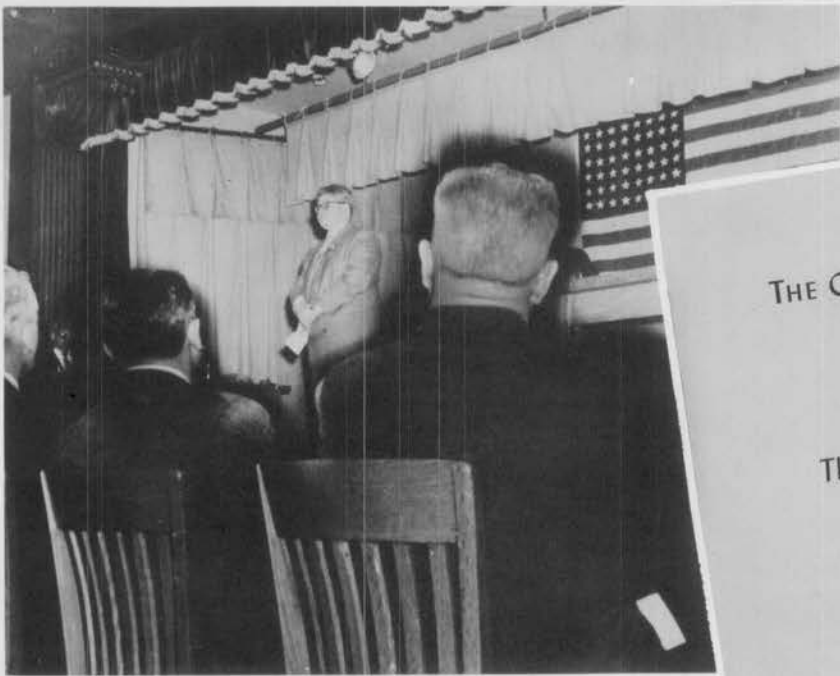


## Mock Trial

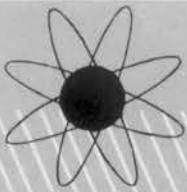
## PERIODIC CHART OF THE ATOMS

### **BROOKLYN PREP 6 ST. FRANCIS 12**

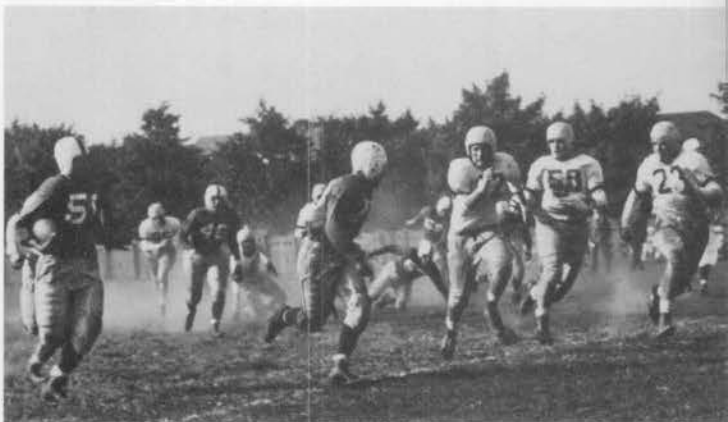

## BROOKLYN PREP 25 FORDHAM PREP 6

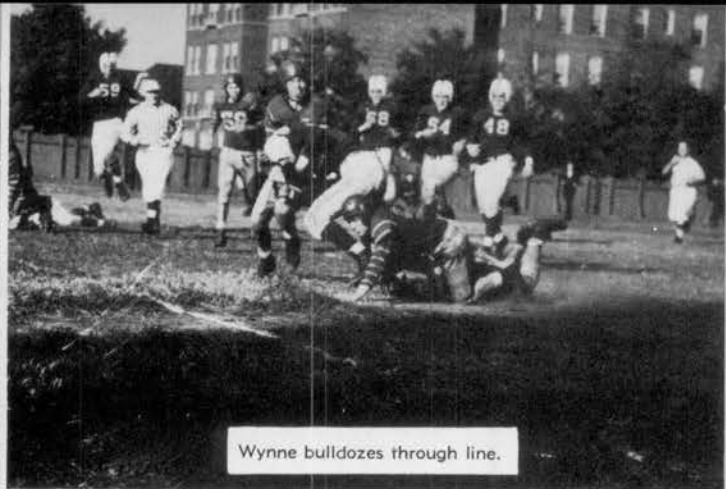
Held scoreless for two quarters by a spirited Ram team, Brooklyn Prep suddenly exploded in the second half.

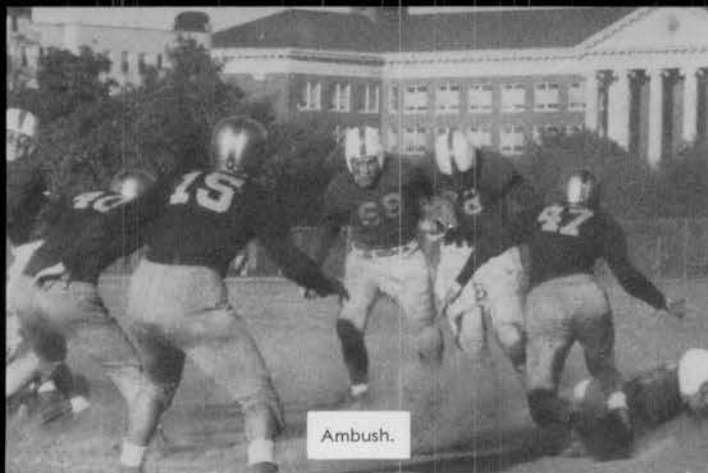
### BROOKLYN PREP 12 ST. CECILIA 20

## Swimming Team

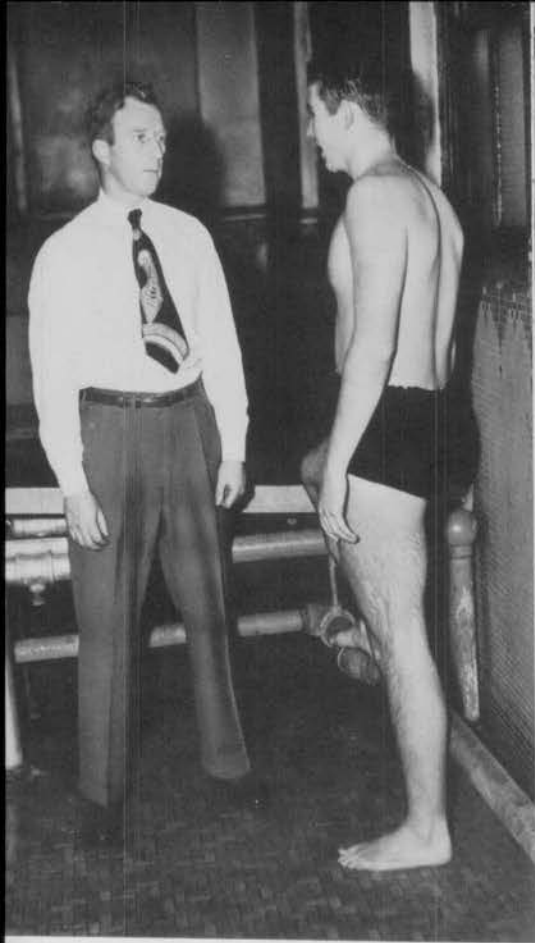

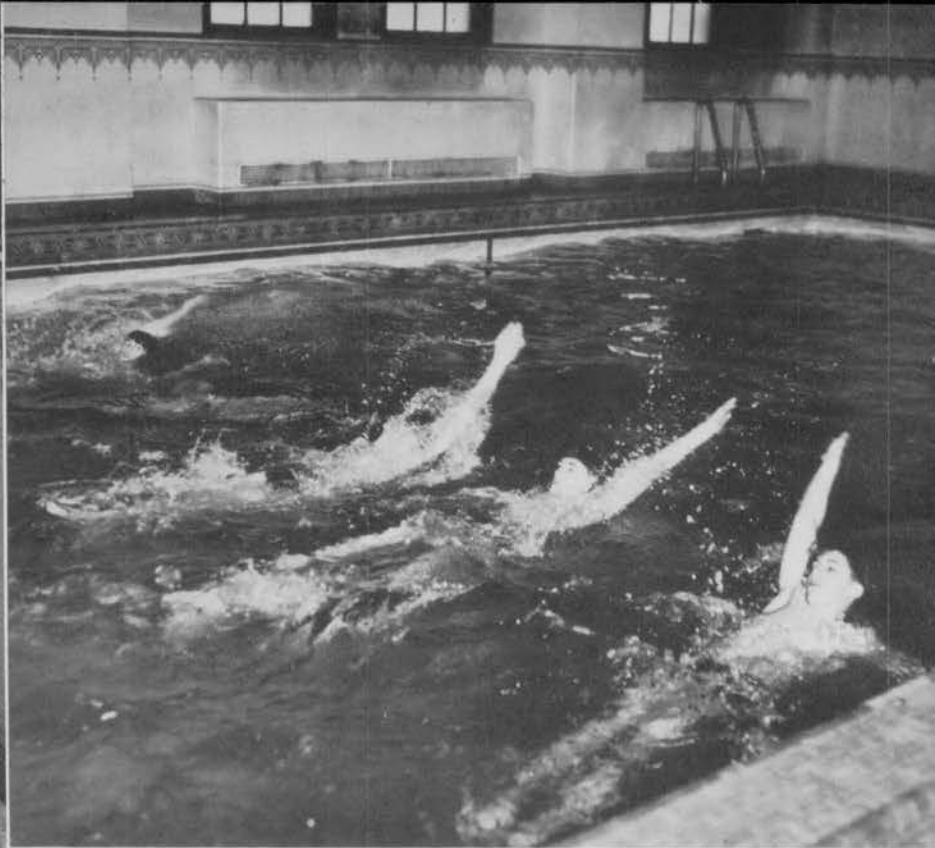
We had more than able representation in the 220 yard dash with Frosh Jim McCarthy who distinguished himself among the mermen by being chosen All-Scholastic.
