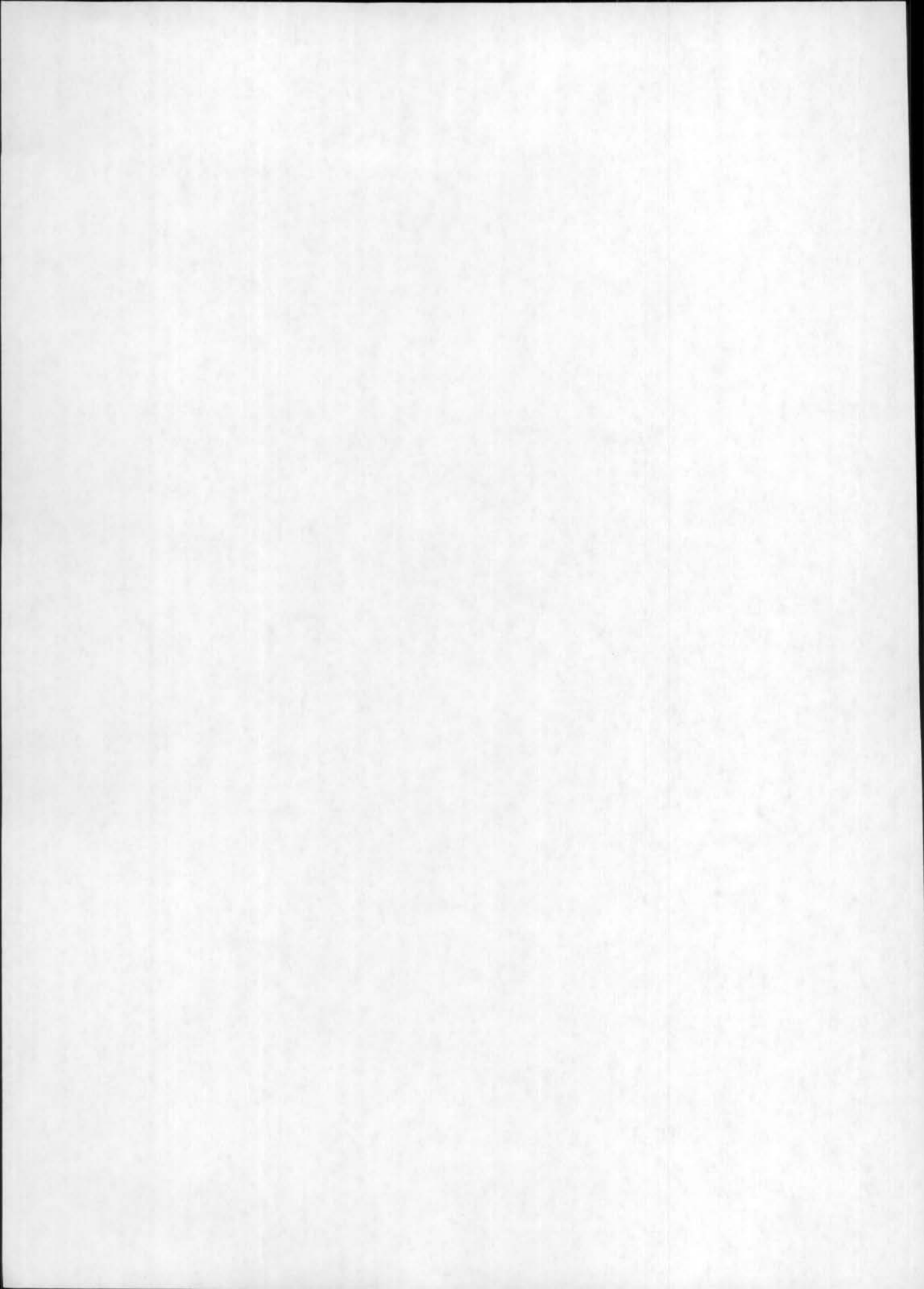

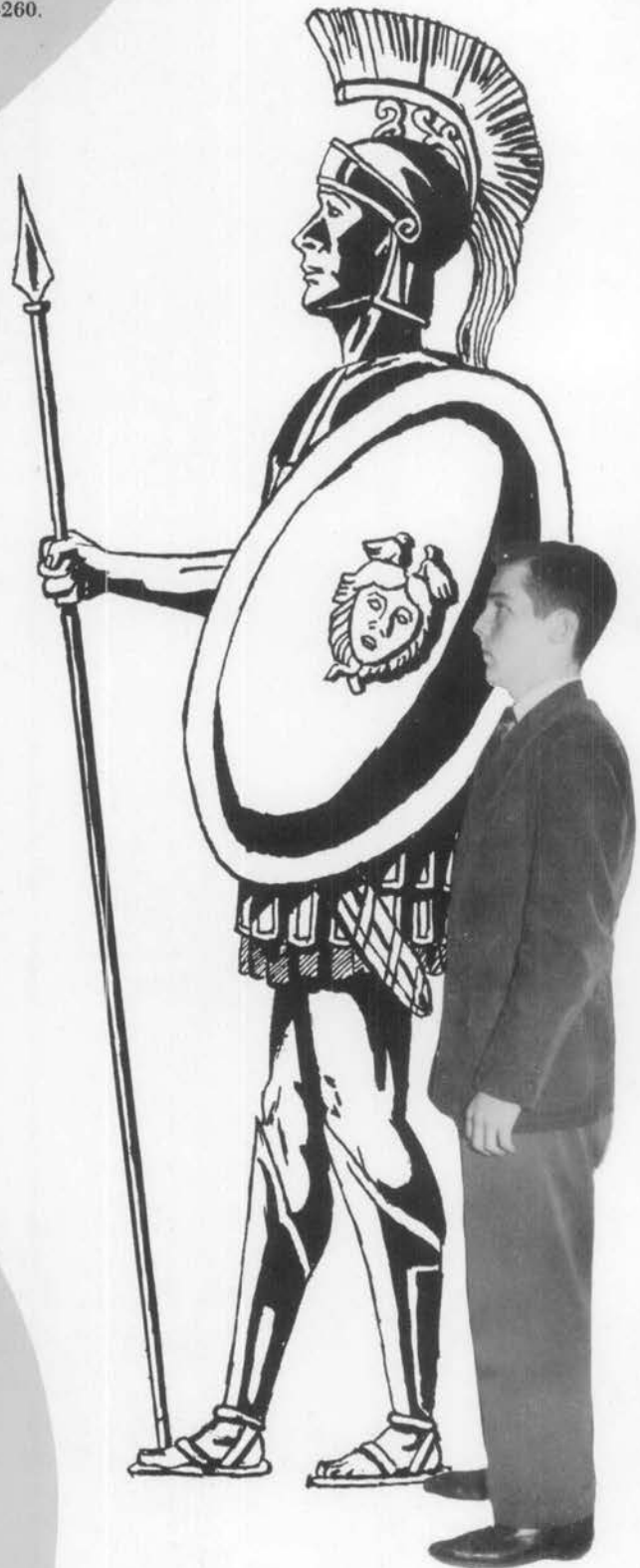

# Foreword

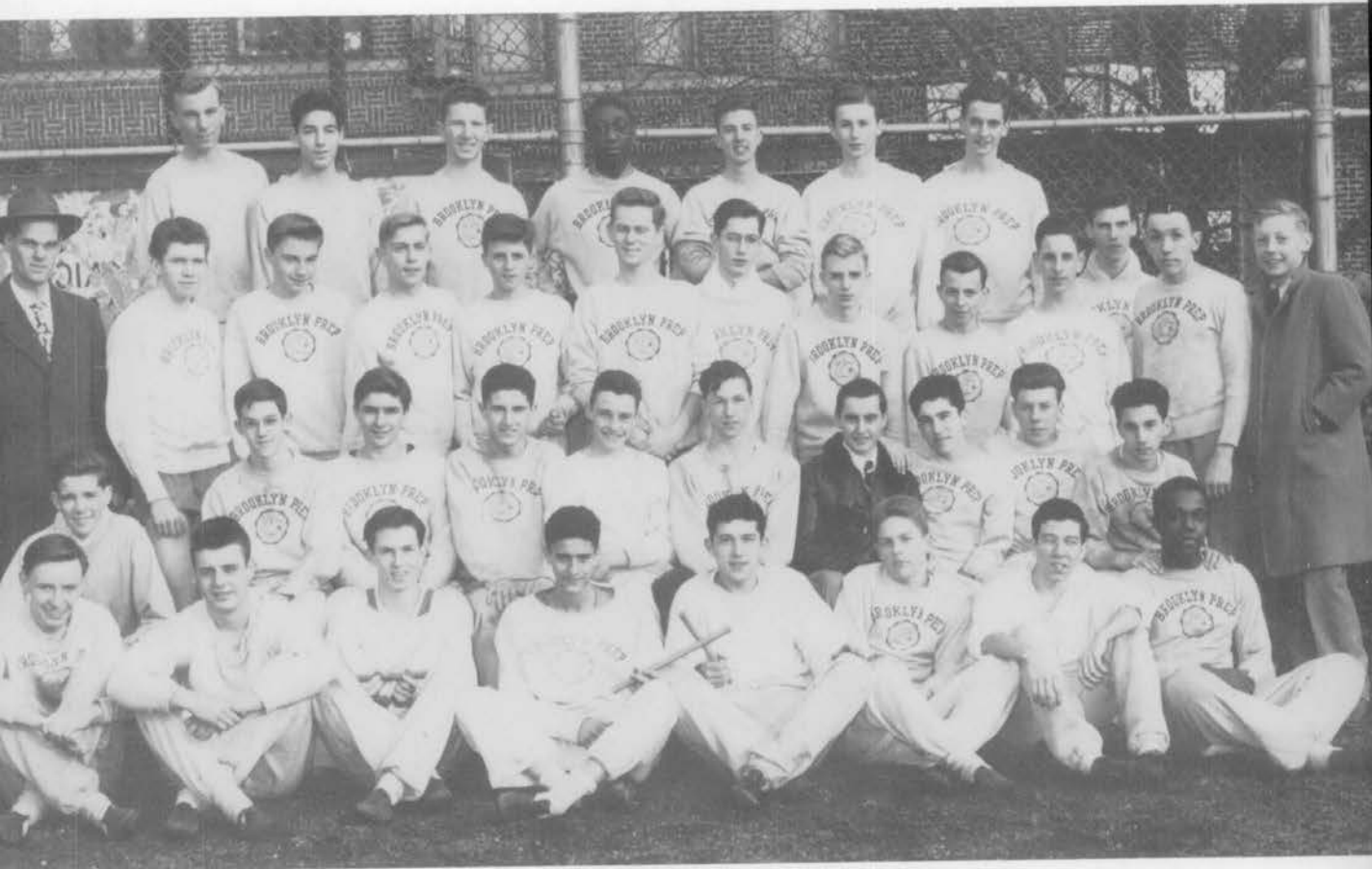

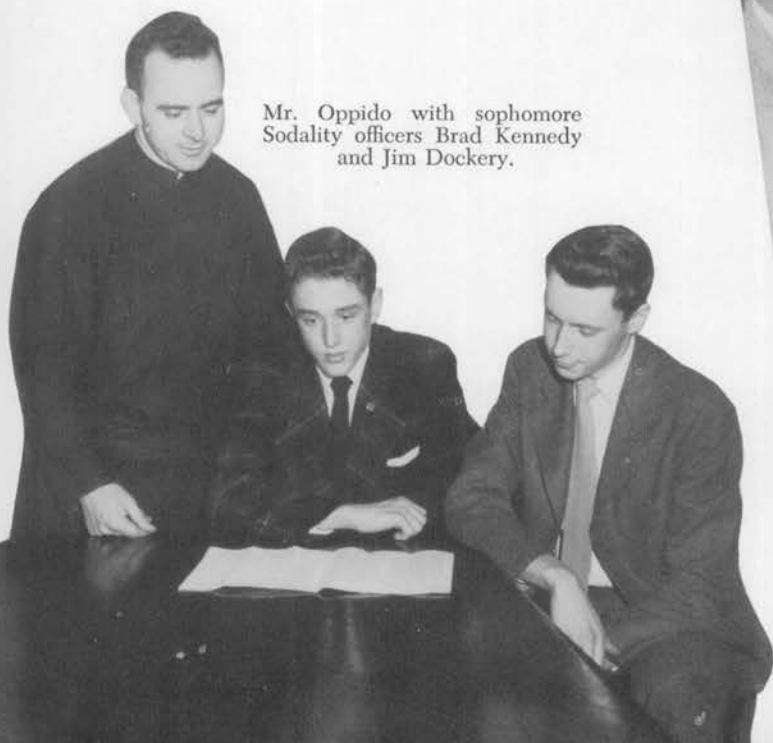

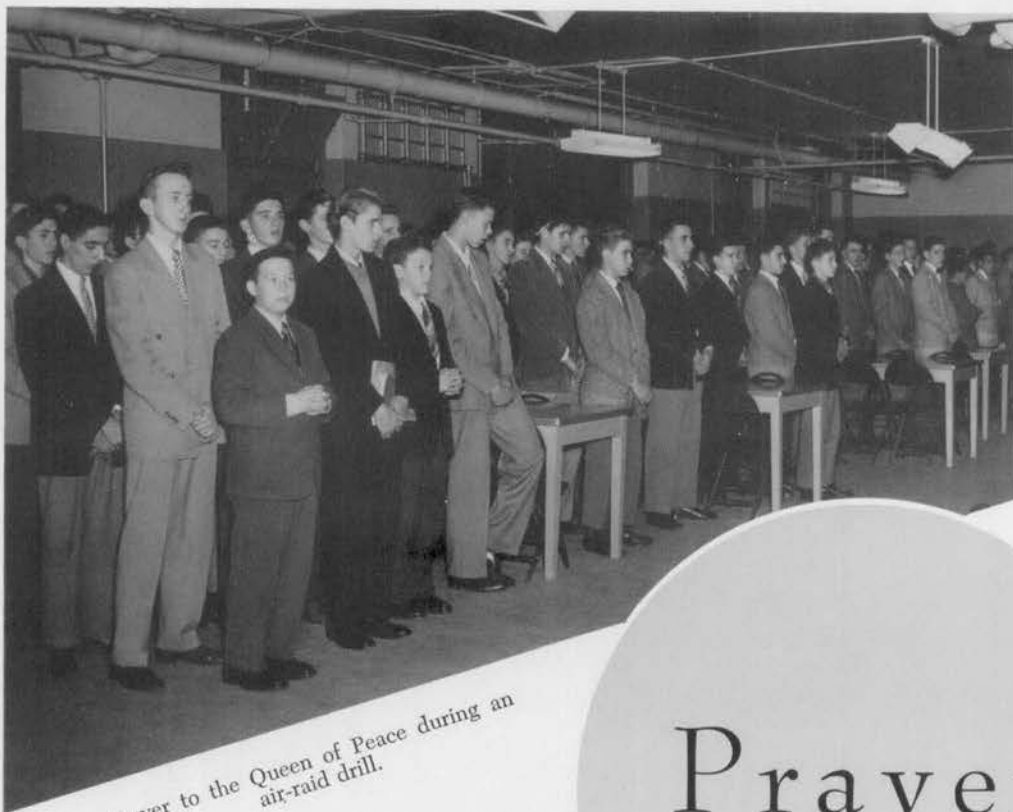

## Locals Capture All Nine Events

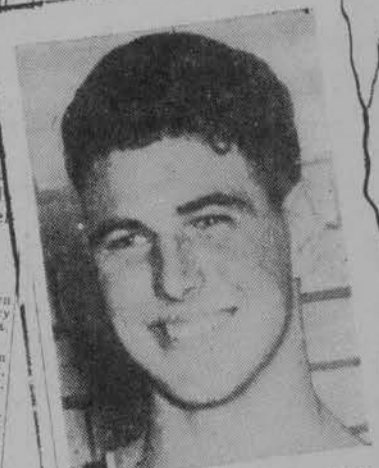
