To these four "gone, but not forgotten" Jesuit priests, we, the Class of 1961, dedicate our Blue Book.





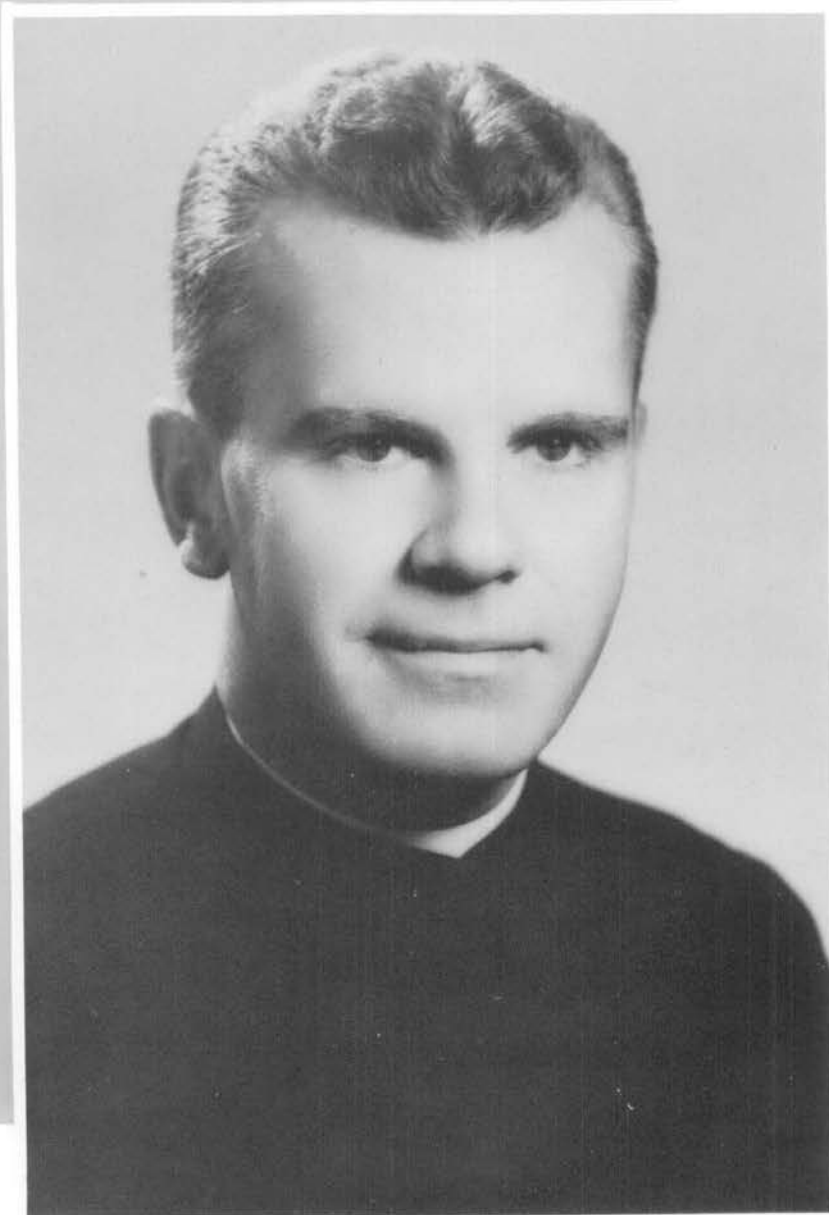
FACULTY

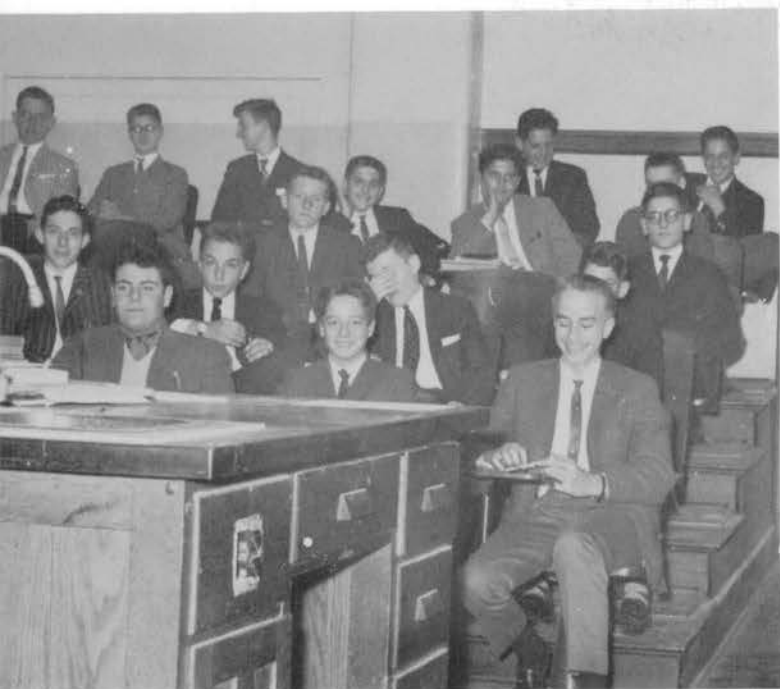

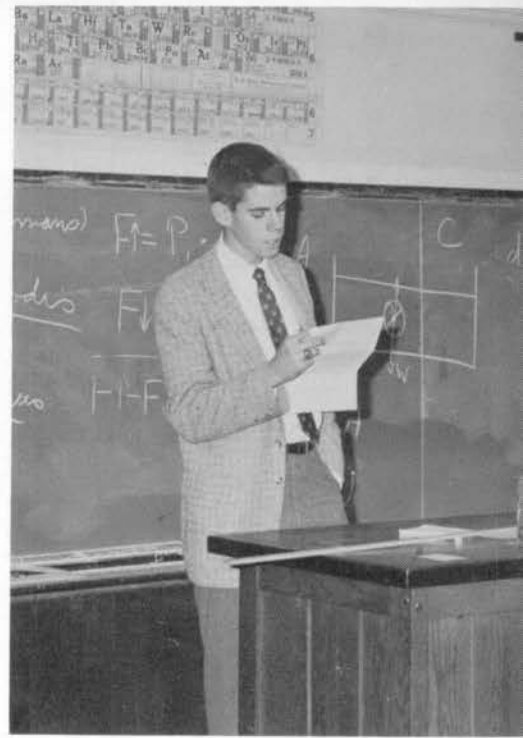

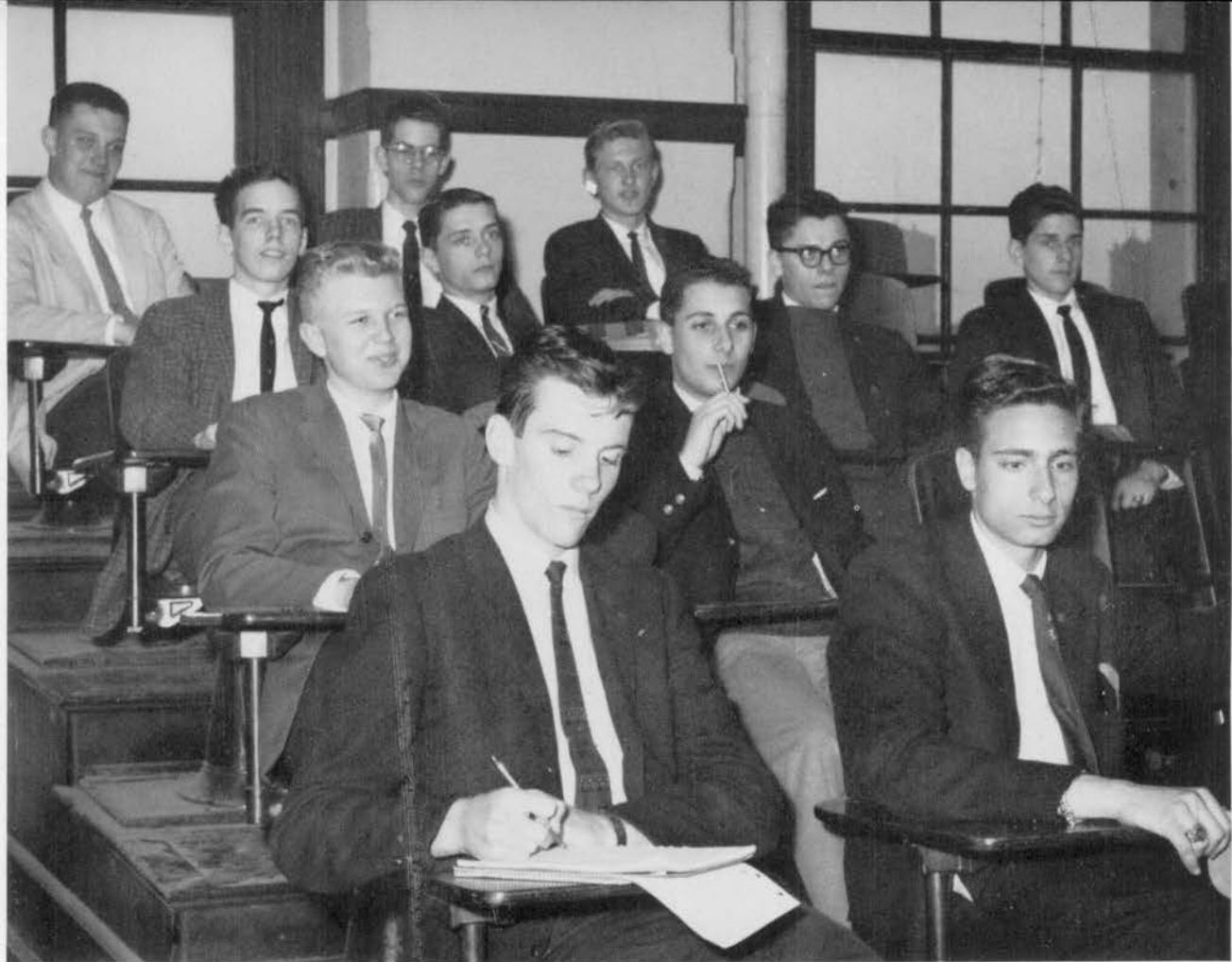

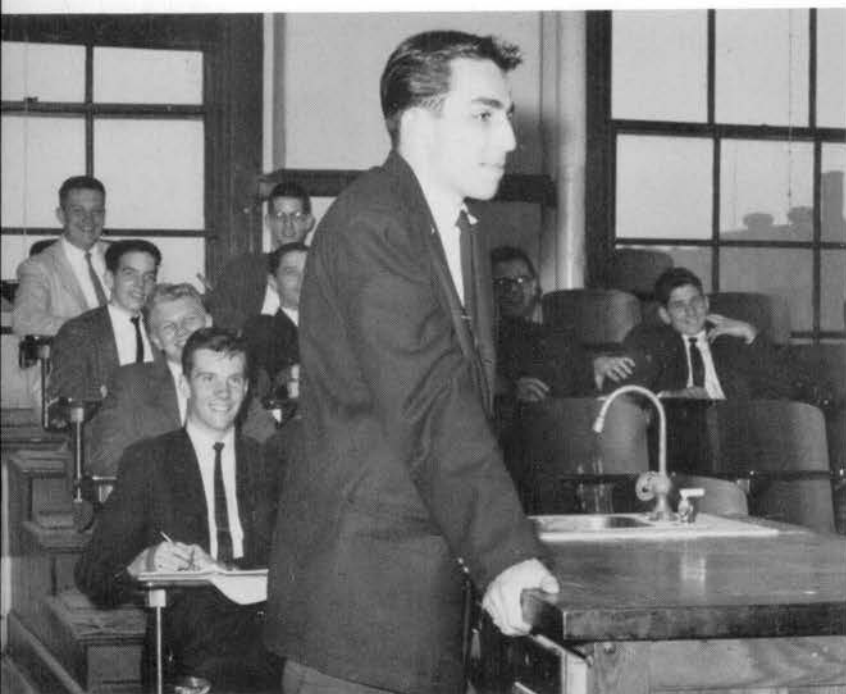

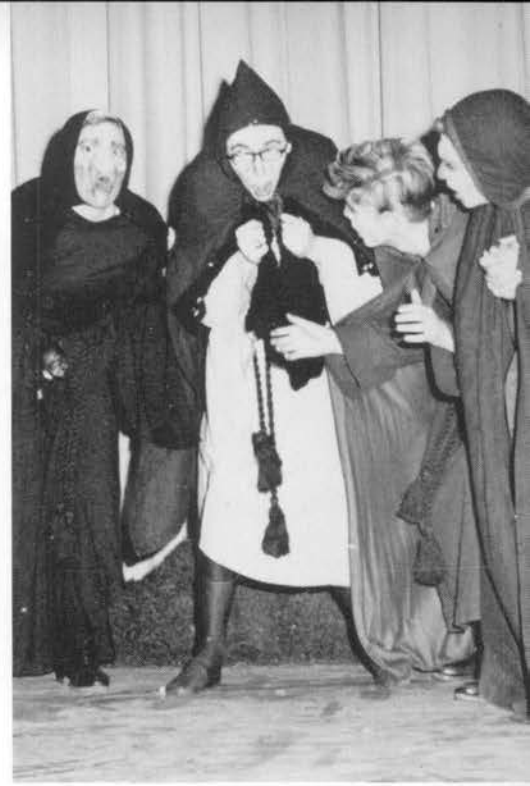

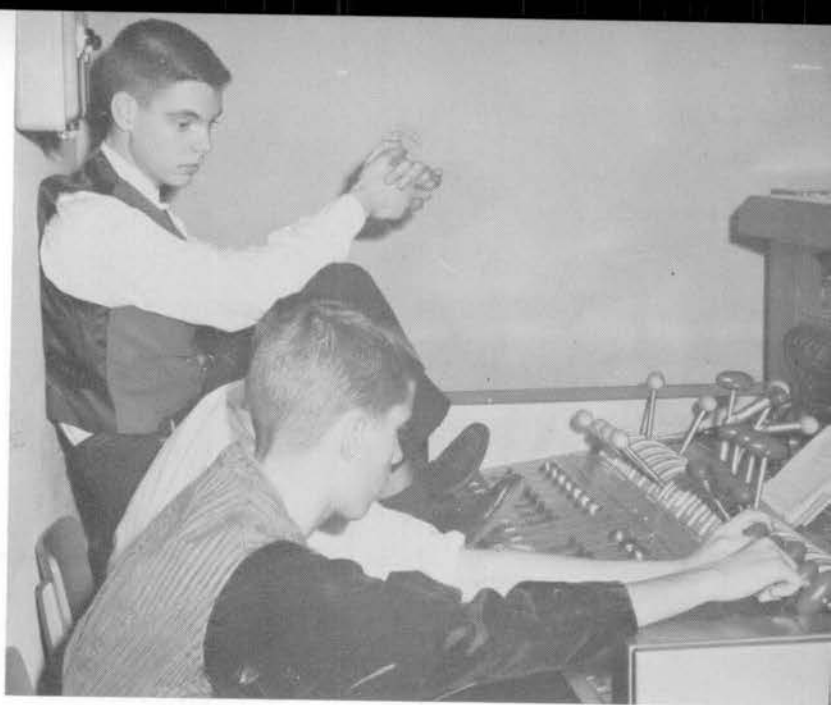

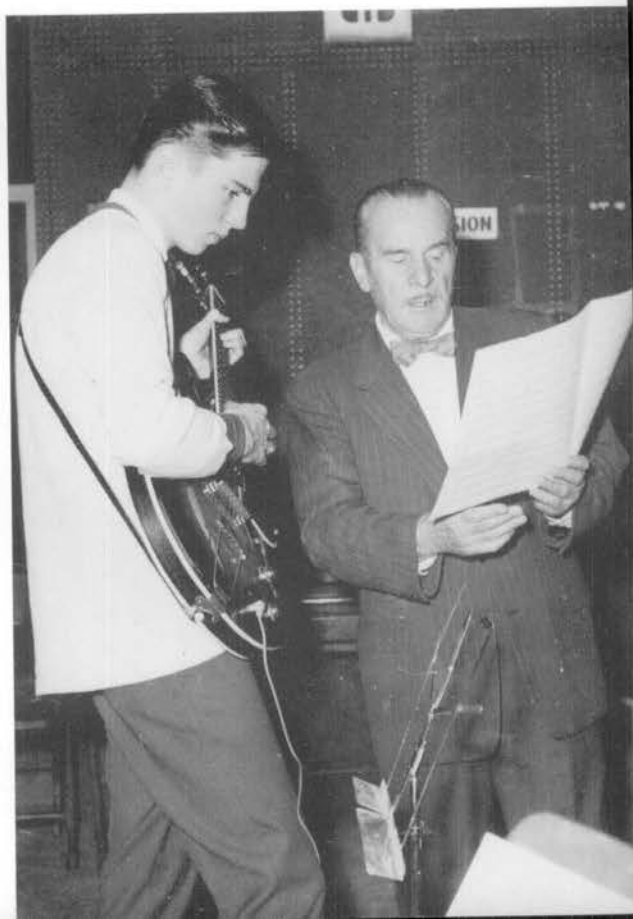

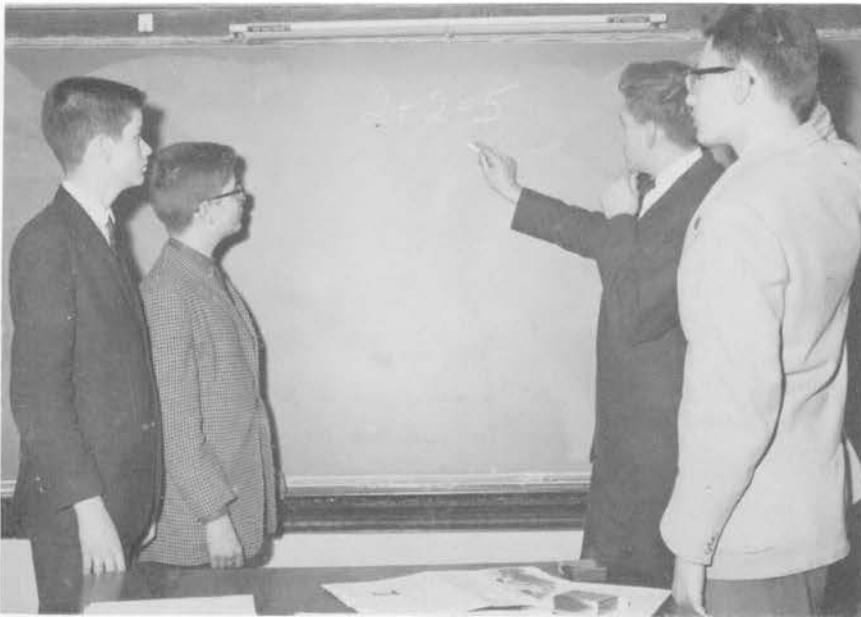

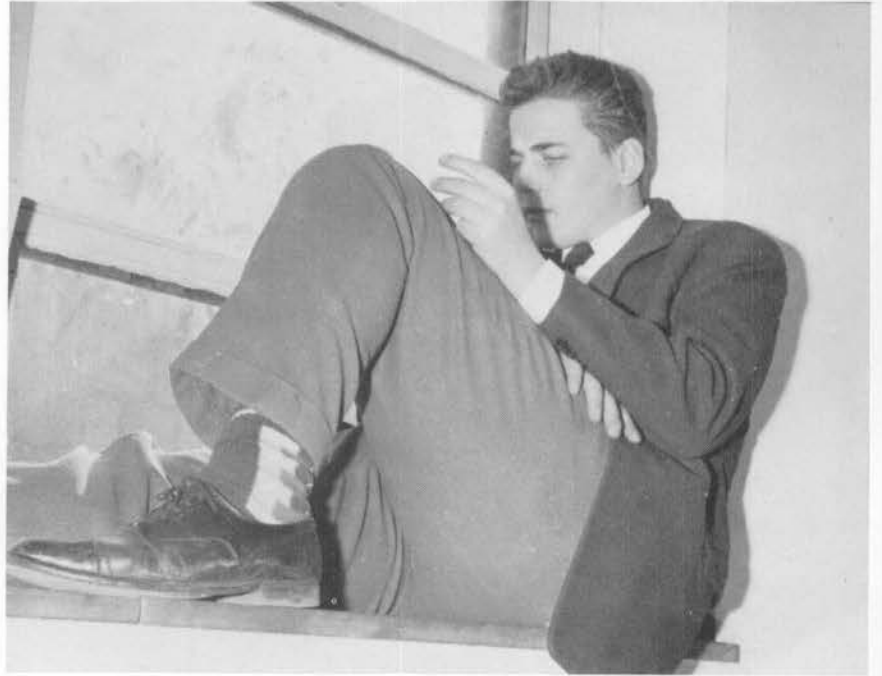

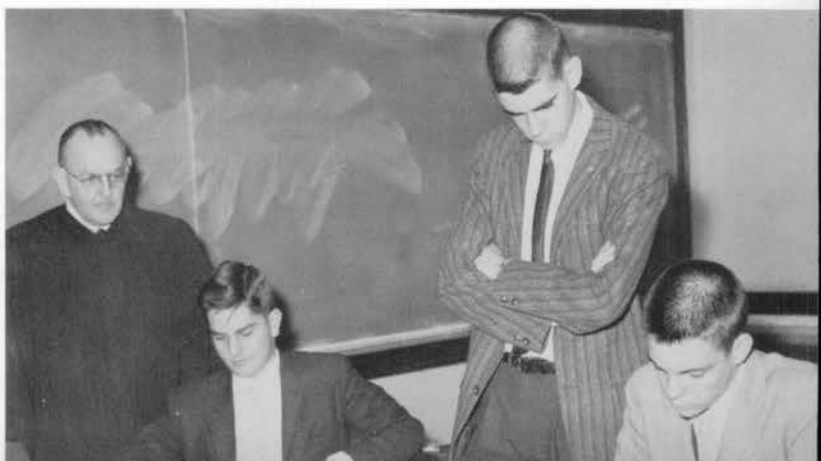

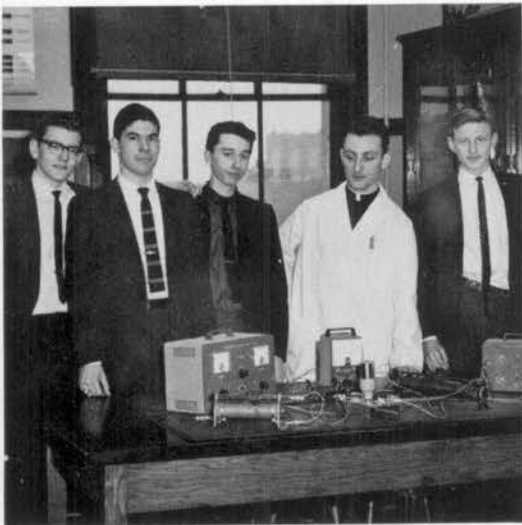

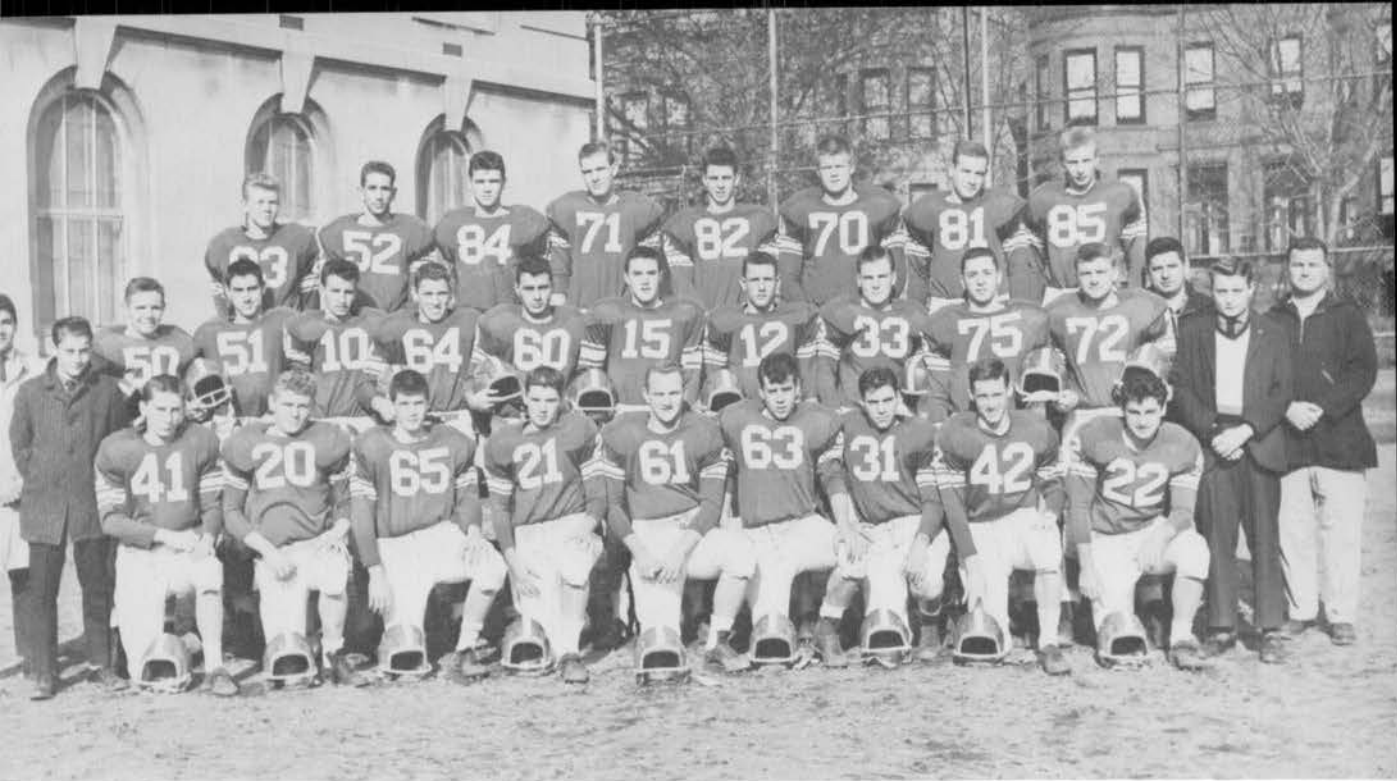

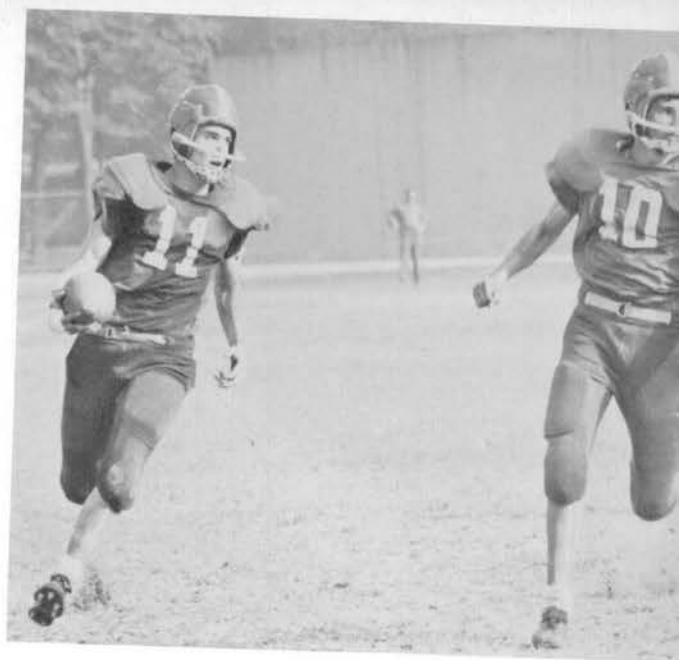
CADETS CRUSHED AT CORNWALL, 27-13

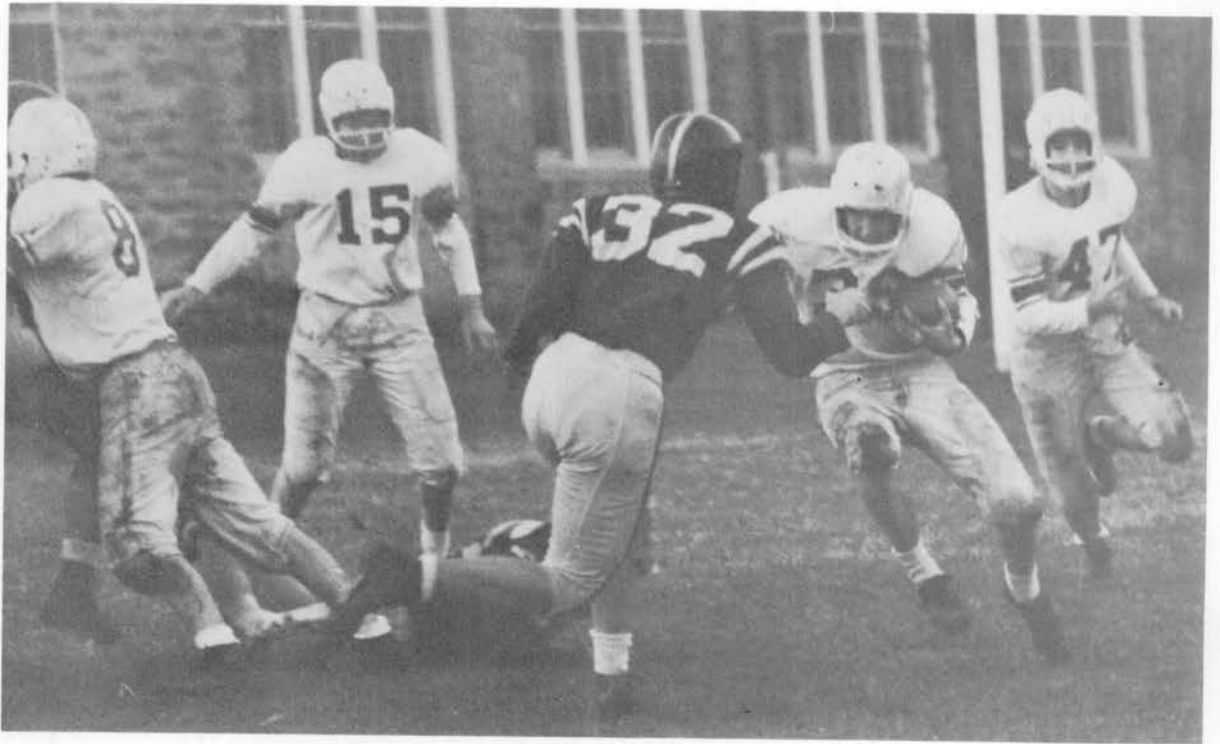

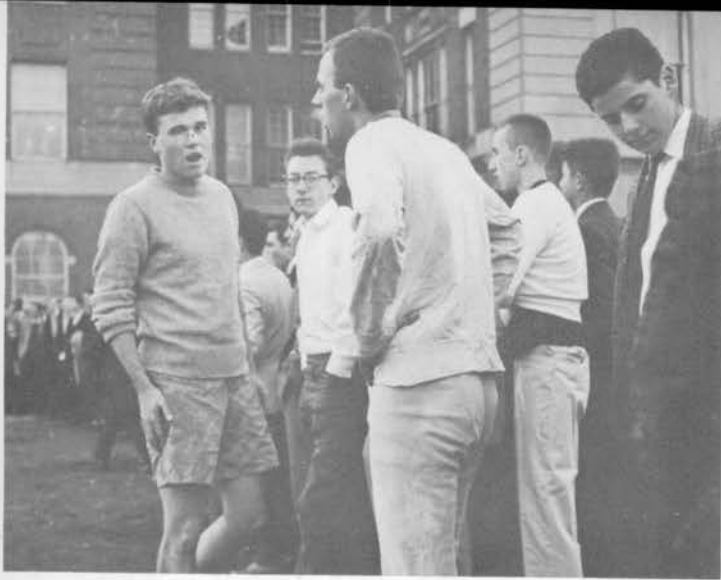

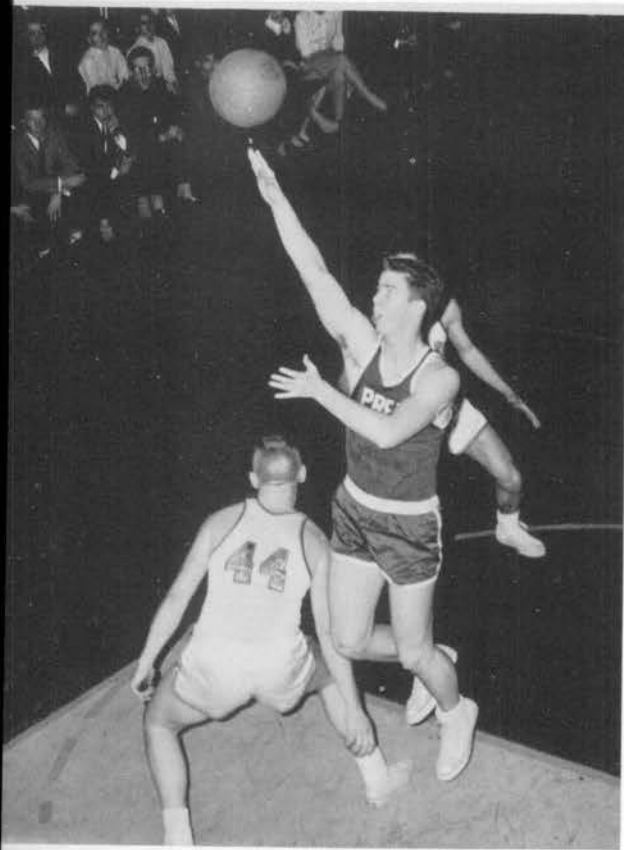
BROOKLYN BASKETEERS MARRED BY MISHAPS

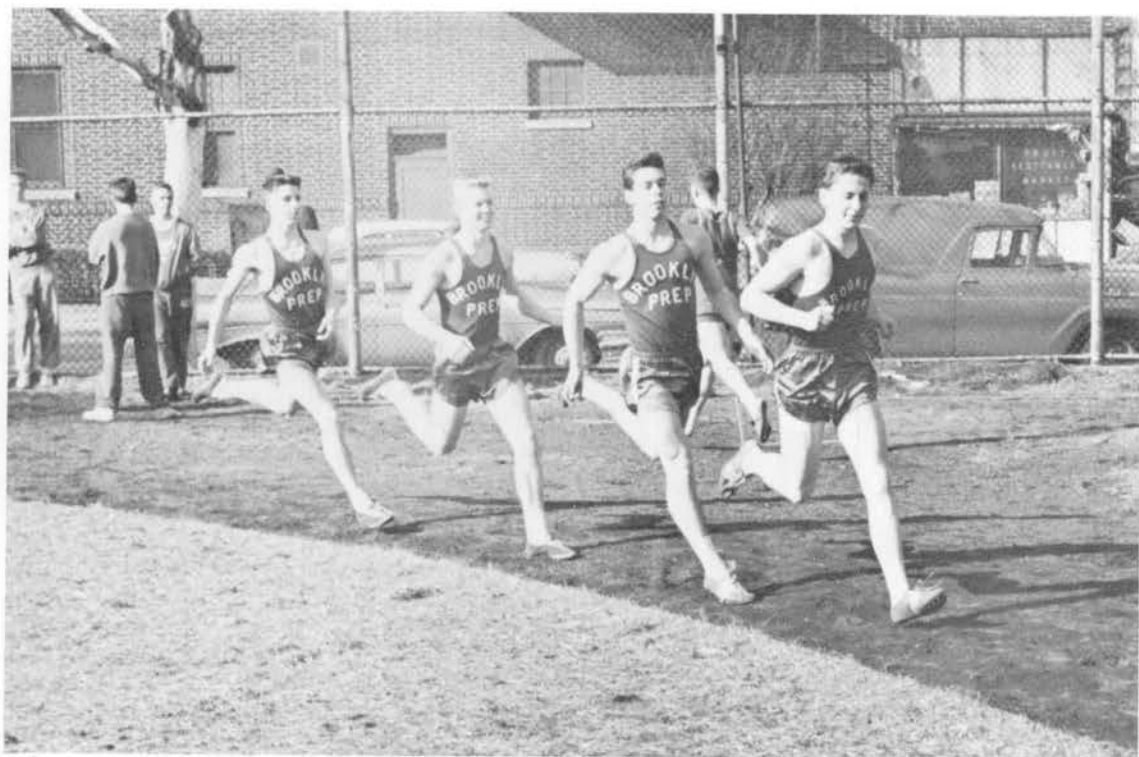

Over the hills of Van Cortlandt Park, Prep's cross country team played a successful part in the sports drama. Behind the fine running of Seniors Stan Bartnikowski and Tom Kraft and Junior Bobby Clarke, the Eagles placed high on the list in every meet they entered. Bartnikowski turned in the best time for the 2½ mile course with a 13:51 clocking. The high point of the season was the capturing of the team trophy in the Jesuit Championships for the first time in five years. Clarke proved himself one of the best Juniors in the city as he captured first place with a 14:03 clocking.

The scene shifts and the props are now banked wooden tracks and quarter mile cinder paths. The shot of a starting gun is heard and once again Prep is on the way to victory. This year the two mile and sprint relay team stole the spotlight from individual performances.

The two mile quartet of Co-Captains Kraft and Bartnikowski together with Juniors Clarke and Bob Bartolini overcame a strong Fordham team at the Jesuit relays for the prized gold medal. With Dan Lanigan replacing Bartnikowski in C.H.S.A.A. championships at Madison Square Garden, the foursome took fifth place among the city's best.

Again at the Jesuit relays, in which Prep won two of the four varsity contests, the six lap relay regulars (Tom Doody, Fred Bleakley, Doug Behr, and Dennis Hurley) captured first place. Earlier in the season the depth of the Eagle sprinters was shown when the 880 relay team (Tom Doody, Frank DelCasino, Doug Behr and Sandy Gradler) took the second place silver medals at the C.H.S.A.A. relay carnival.

In field events, the javelin throwing of Fred Bleakley and pole-vaulting of Joe Battle proved to be valuable point getters for Coach Lawrence's team.

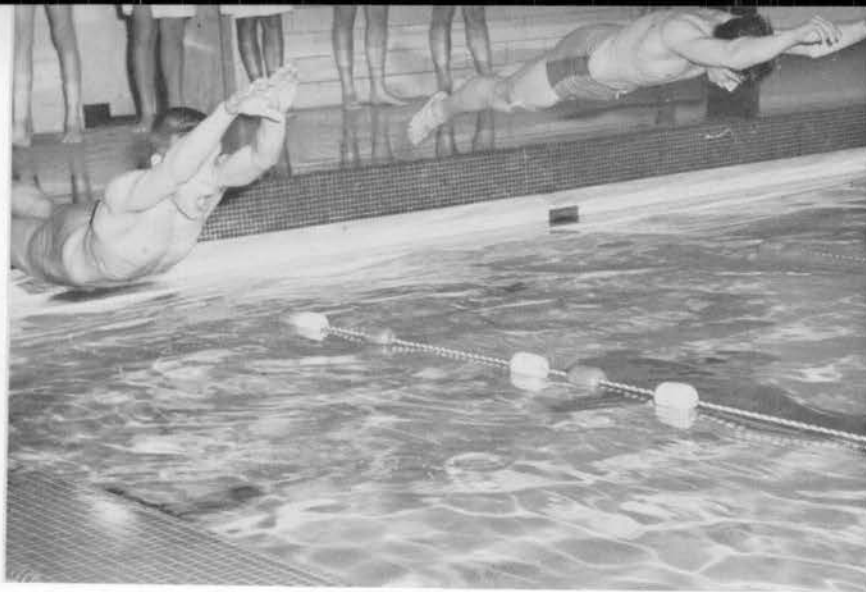

This season was fair, but the team looks forward to greater feats in the coming seasons.



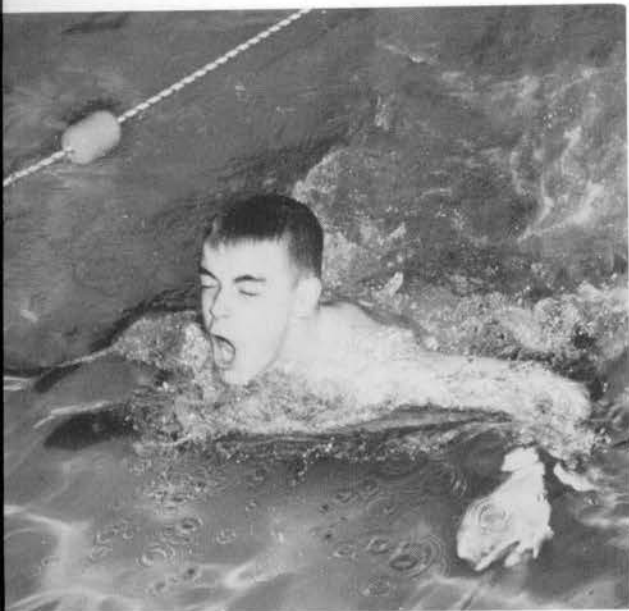
