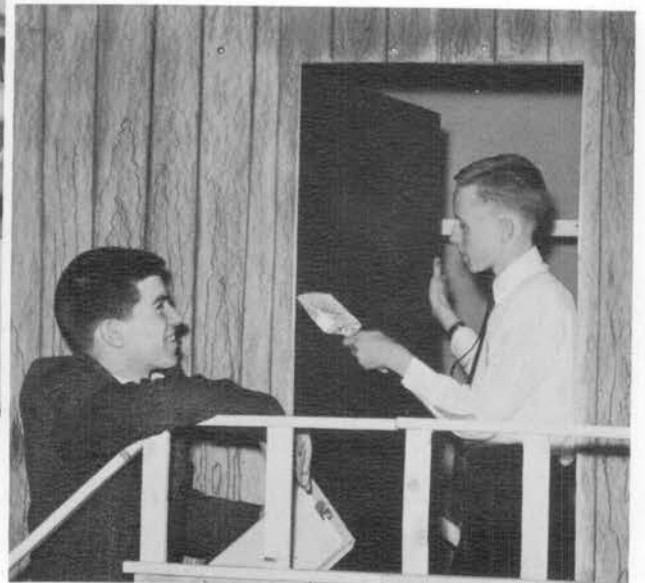

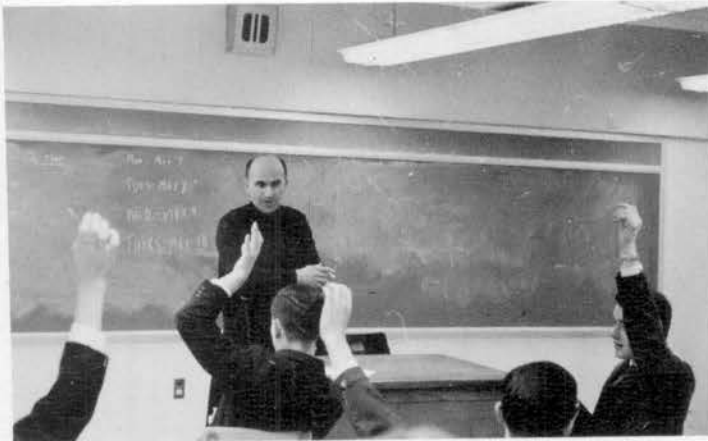

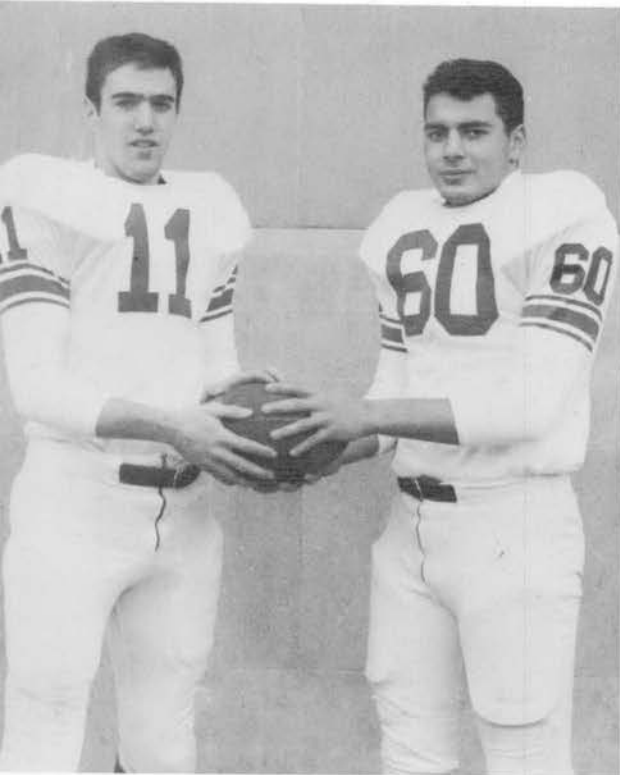

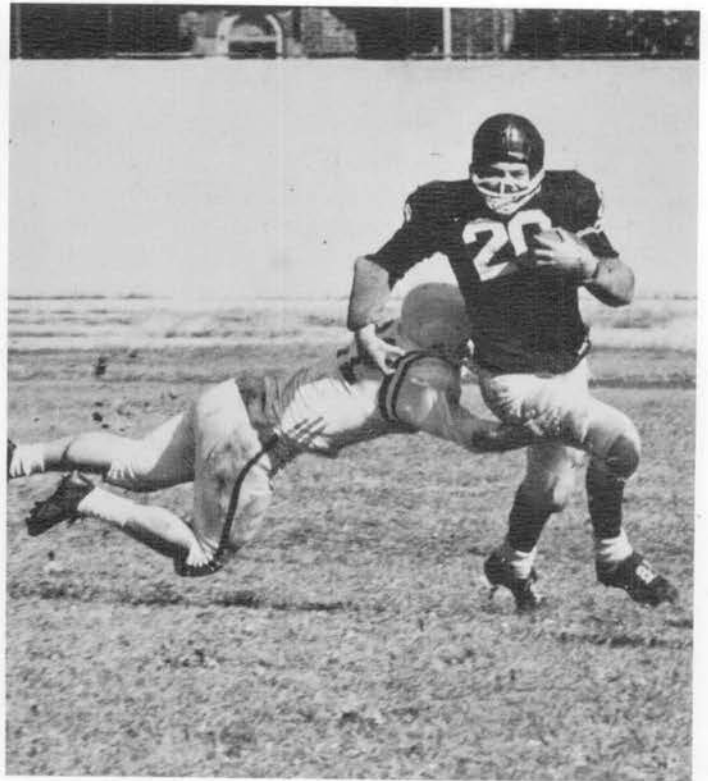

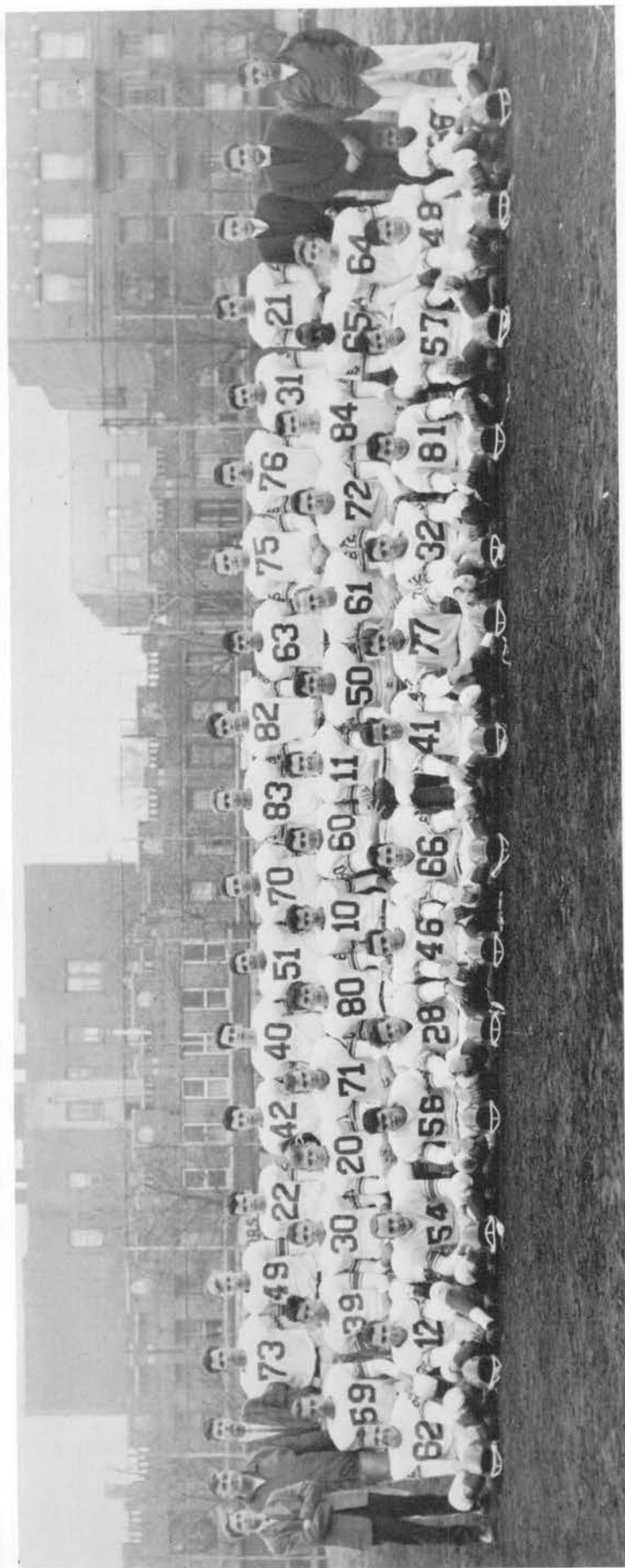

A vote of thanks to the Prep linemen who saved the day.



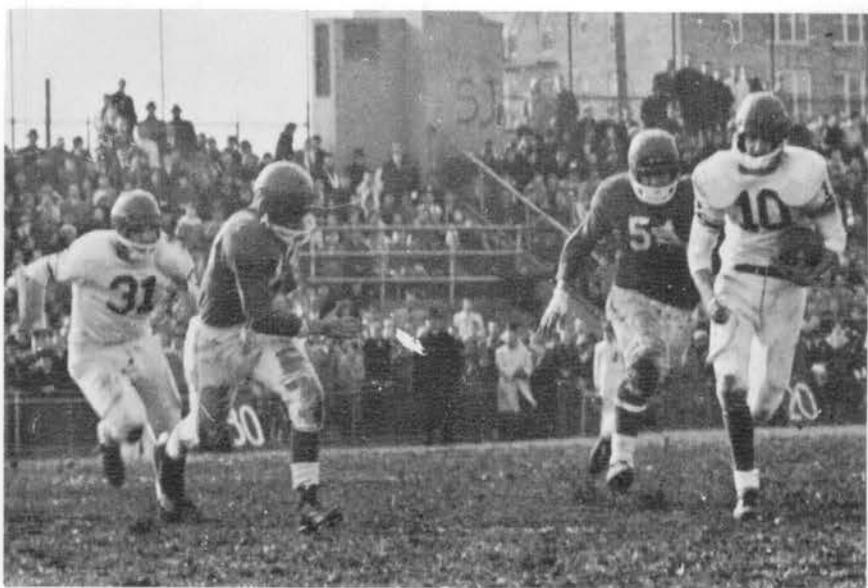

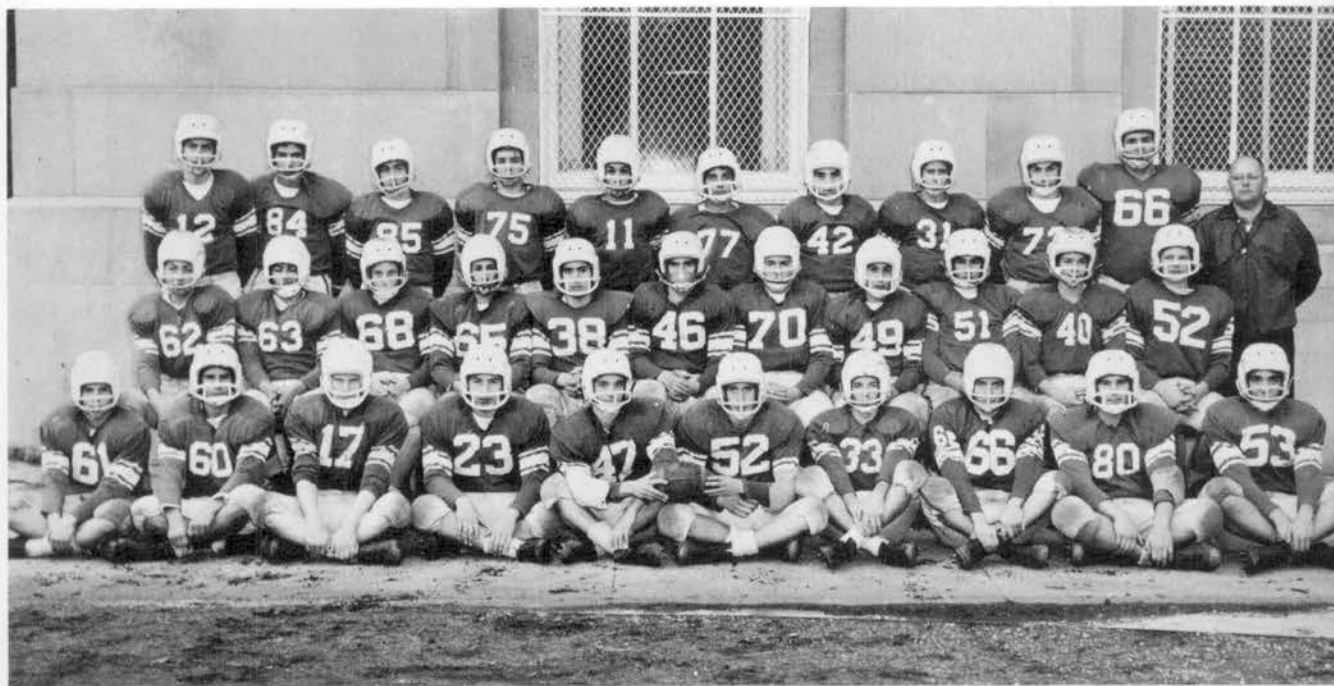

The success story of the 1962 Prep track team is chiefly a record of the numerous stellar performances by upperclassmen. Under the reliable coaching of Murt Lawrence and the leadership of co-captains Den Hurley and Bob Clarke, the Eagles turned in a victorious slate. The chief 'success factors' were the triumphant performances of the relay teams. This, augmented by a number of fine individual efforts, led to broken records which were the cause for much pride and jubilation on the part of both the team and the Prep.

This year the spotlight was on the two-mile relay platoon. The team of Steve Long, Dan Lanigan, Bobby Clarke, and Bob Bartolini placed fourth in a field of thirty schools at the Loughlin Games. With Soph Bill Azzinaro replacing Lanigan in the Jesuit Relays, the quartet easily copped gold medals. However, the highlight of the indoor season did not occur until February 24, when the original foursome of Long, Lanigan, Clarke, and Bartolini captured third place in the National High School Championships among a field of the most talented runners on the Eastern Seaboard. The Eagles' time of 8:03.8 established a new school record, erasing the previous mark of 8:06.0 set in 1959.

Due acclaim must also go to the dependable sprint relay teams. Their potential was realized early in the season when the open 880 yard relay quartet of Richie Gallagher, Jim Ellingham, Denny Hurley, and Bob Hickson finished third in the C.H.S.A.A. Relay Carnival. At the Jesuits', the six-lap relay met with success. The junior team was awarded gold medals for their superior effort, while the open foursome settled for silver. In the same meet the combination medley placed first, the open mile relay second.

The Eagles also turned in a number of outstanding individual performances. Dan Lanigan won the open 440 yard sprint in the B.L.I.'s and placed second in the Garden meet, losing his specialty by a sheer tenth of a second. Bartolini's victory in the junior 880 yard run in the latter meet lowered the record for that event.

The talented freshmen, under Assistant Coach Long, will bolster the ranks of next year's team. Frosh, such as Grossberger, Milmo, Abt, and Malliband, along with sophomores Azzinaro, Cunniff, Fedele, Witko, Kane, and K. Lanigan, have shown the ability to continue the Eagles' fine record. The strength of the juniors lies in Gallagher, Petitto, and Petrizzo.

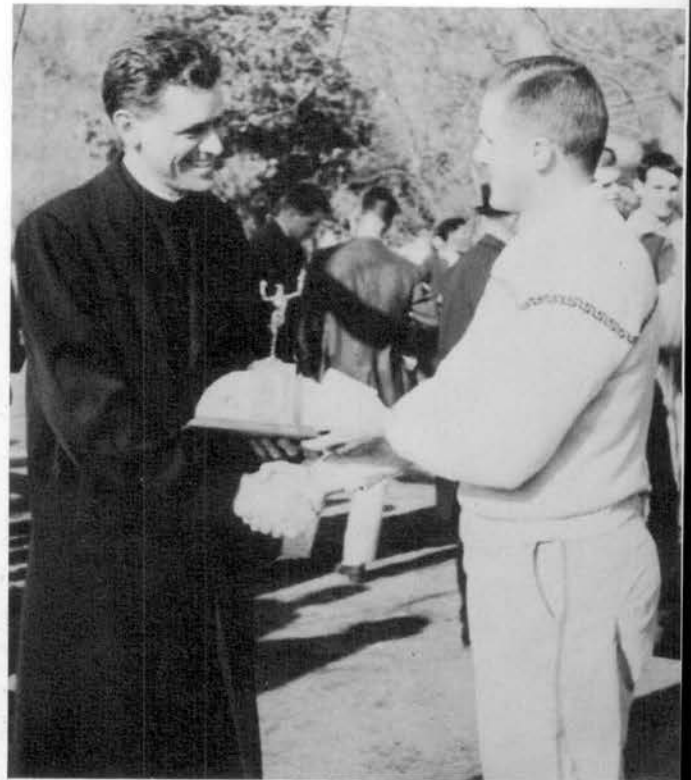

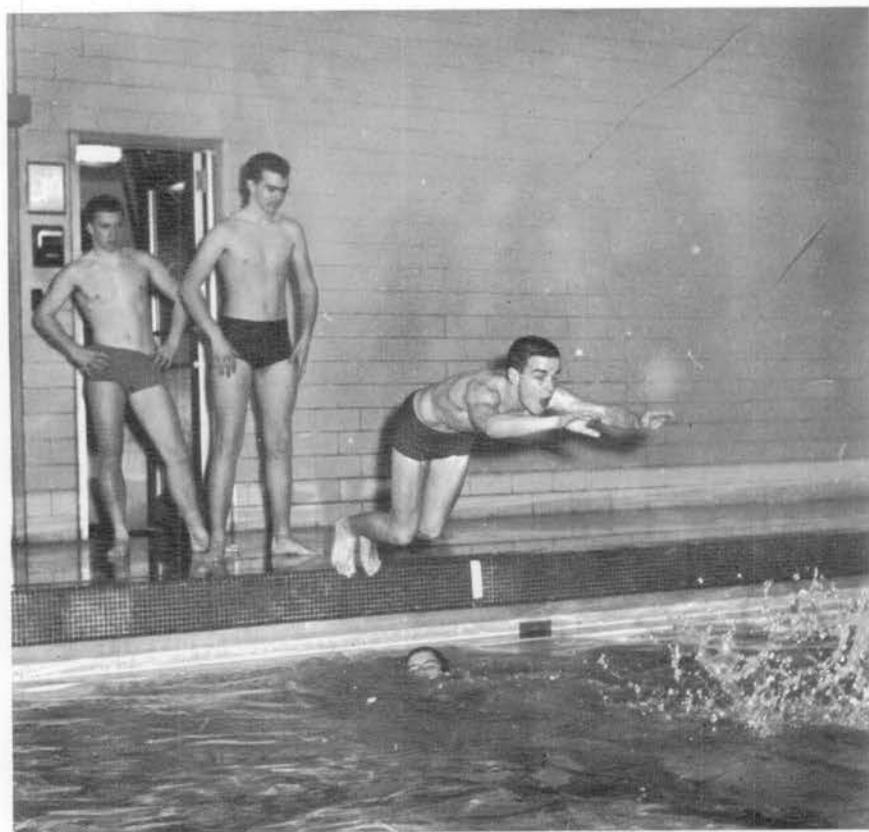
Prep swimmers rose to new heights this season under the guidance of their experienced coach, Mr. Walter Doolan. In the beginning of the season, the team was eager but inexperienced. The tankmen were handed losses by Xavier, St. John's, St. Francis, and Rice. Things changed, however, in the second half of the season when the Prep Finmen sprinted to victories over Holy Cross, Trinity, Regis, and McBurney. Captain Bob Beck climaxed his four-year varsity career by going unbeaten in these eight dual meets.

After these four straight victories, the team was not to be stopped in the post-season championships. They took third place in the Jesuit Swimming Championships and first place in the C.H.S.A.A. Metropolitan Novice Championships. To win the first team trophy in seven years, the Prep tankmen nosed out arch-rival, St. Francis, by three points and set two new records. Ray Miles set a new record (26.1) in the 50-yard freestyle; and the medley relay of John Doherty, Ed Desmond, Ray Miles, and Richie McAteer clocked a time of 2:02.2, taking better than five seconds off the old record.

Despite the loss of these outstanding swimmers, Coach Doolan is looking forward to a championship team next season, led by veteran lettermen John Doherty, Ray Miles, Tony Fiore, Ed Desmond, Richie McAteer, and Vic Howard. 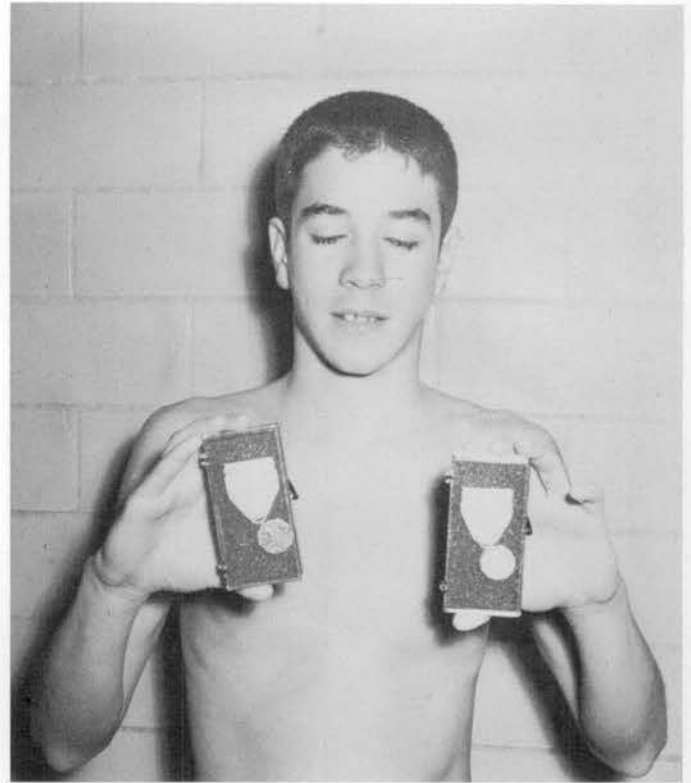
