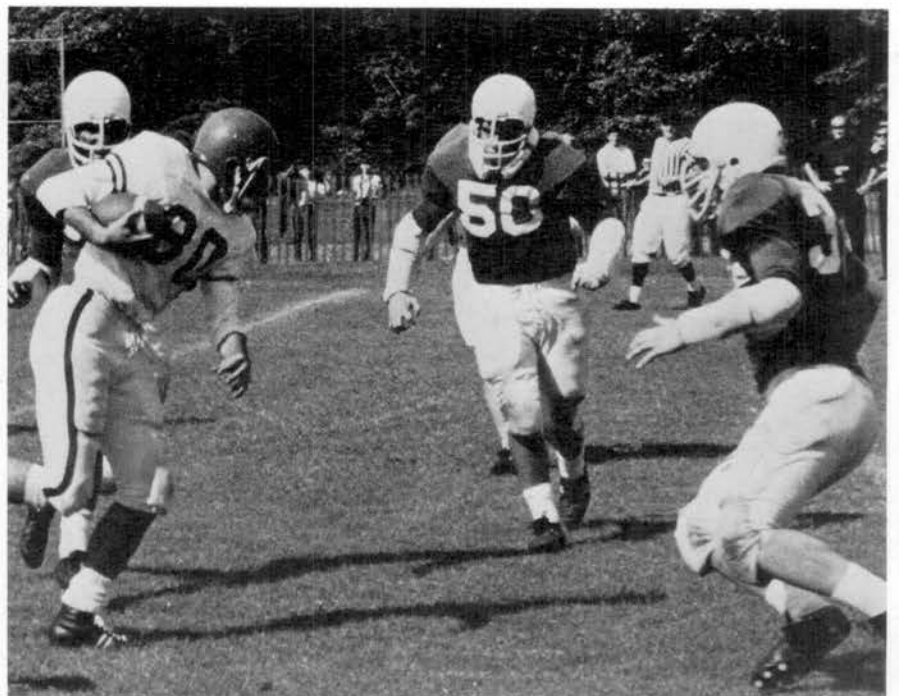

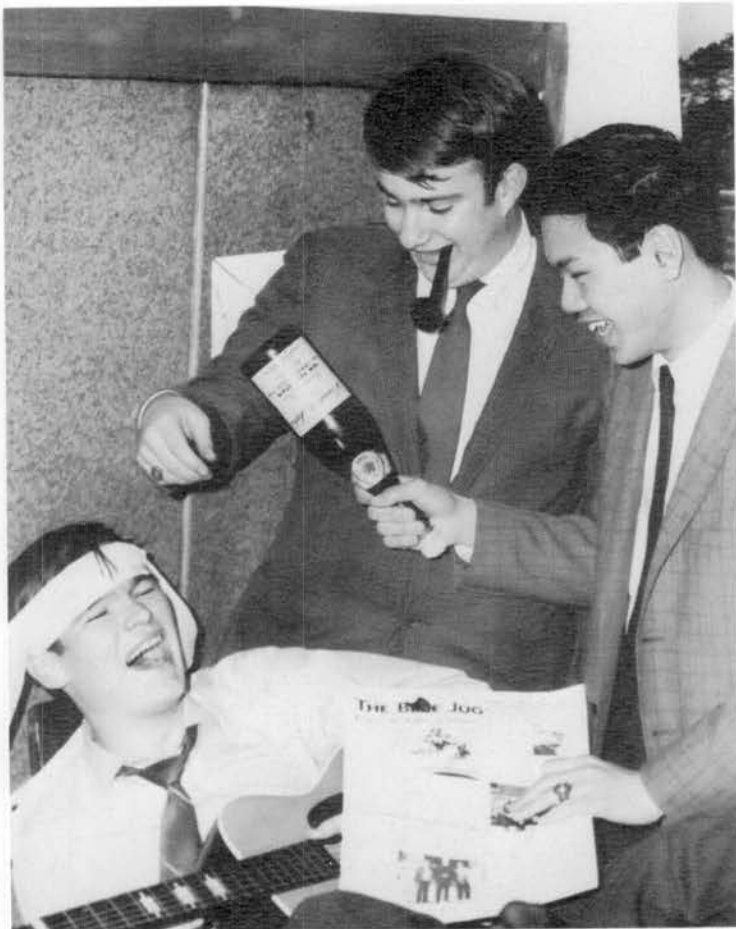


## *Blue Jug*

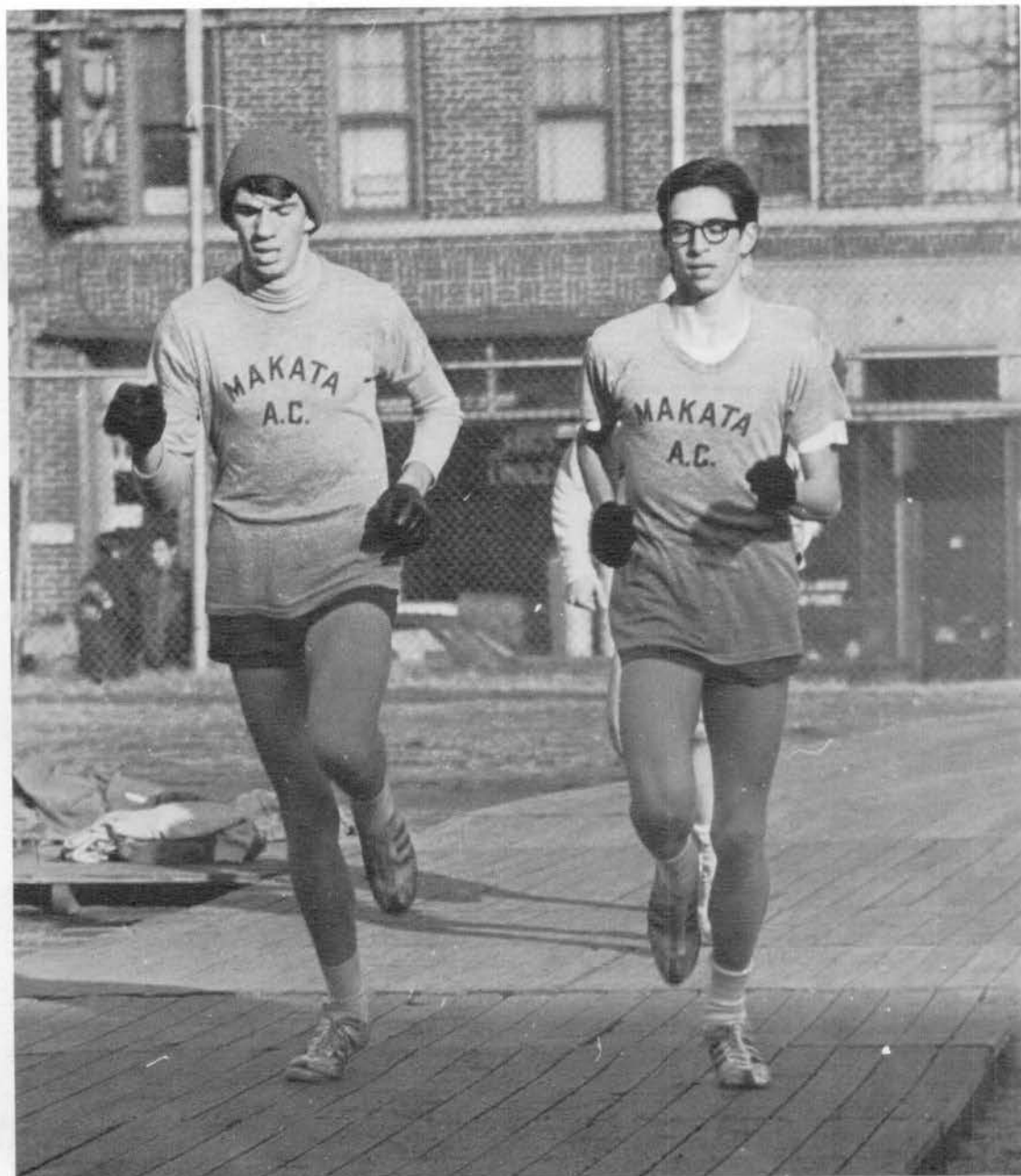
# Cross Country

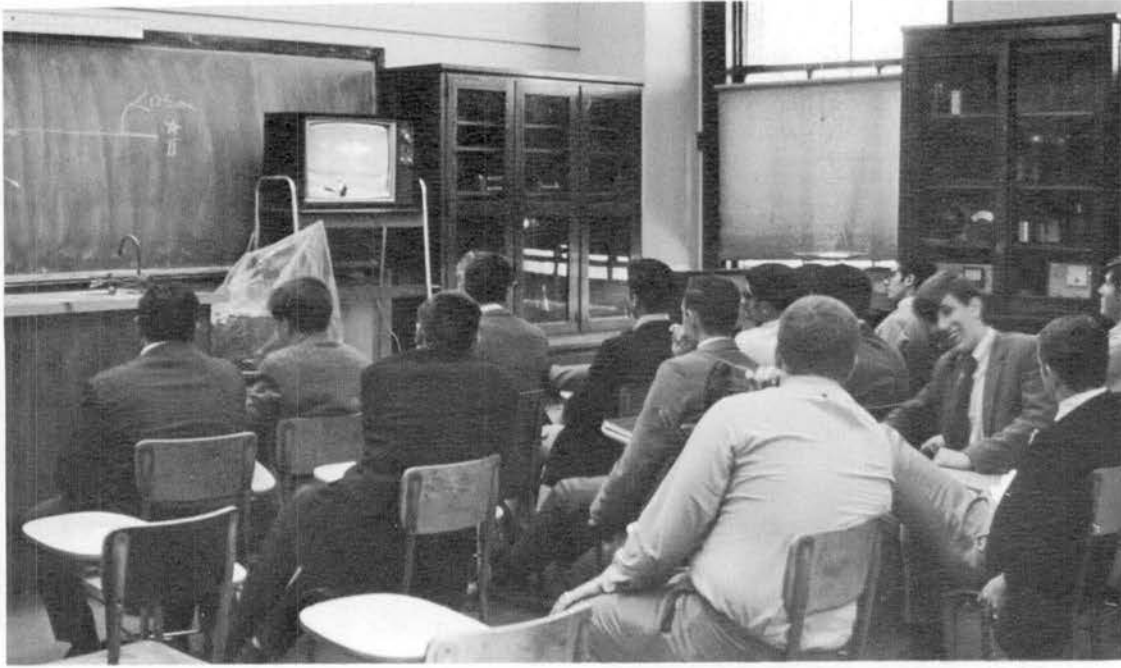

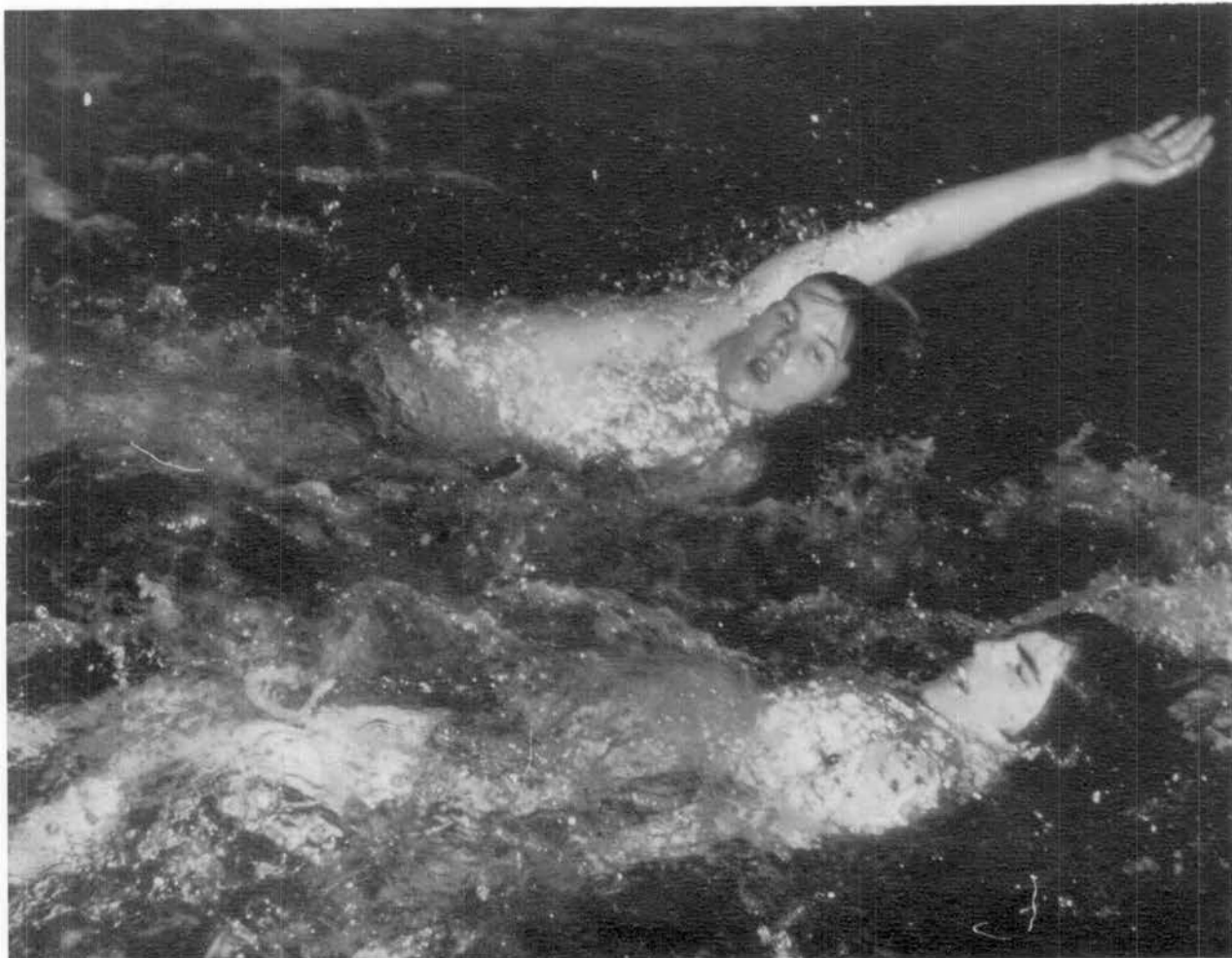
# Swimming

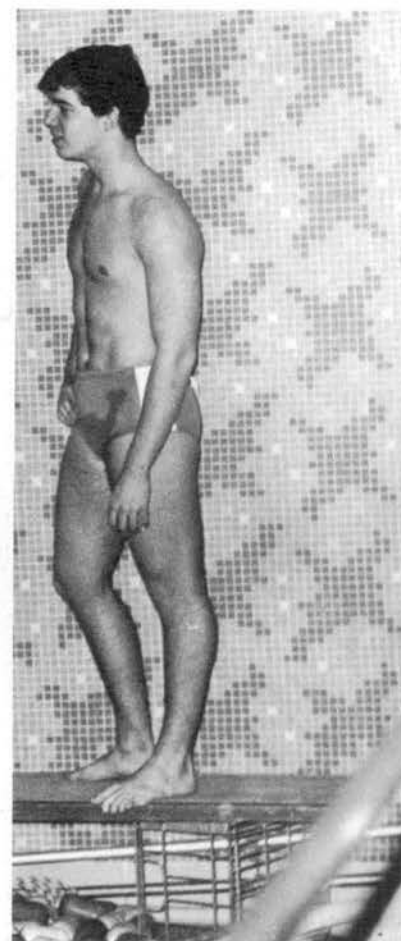

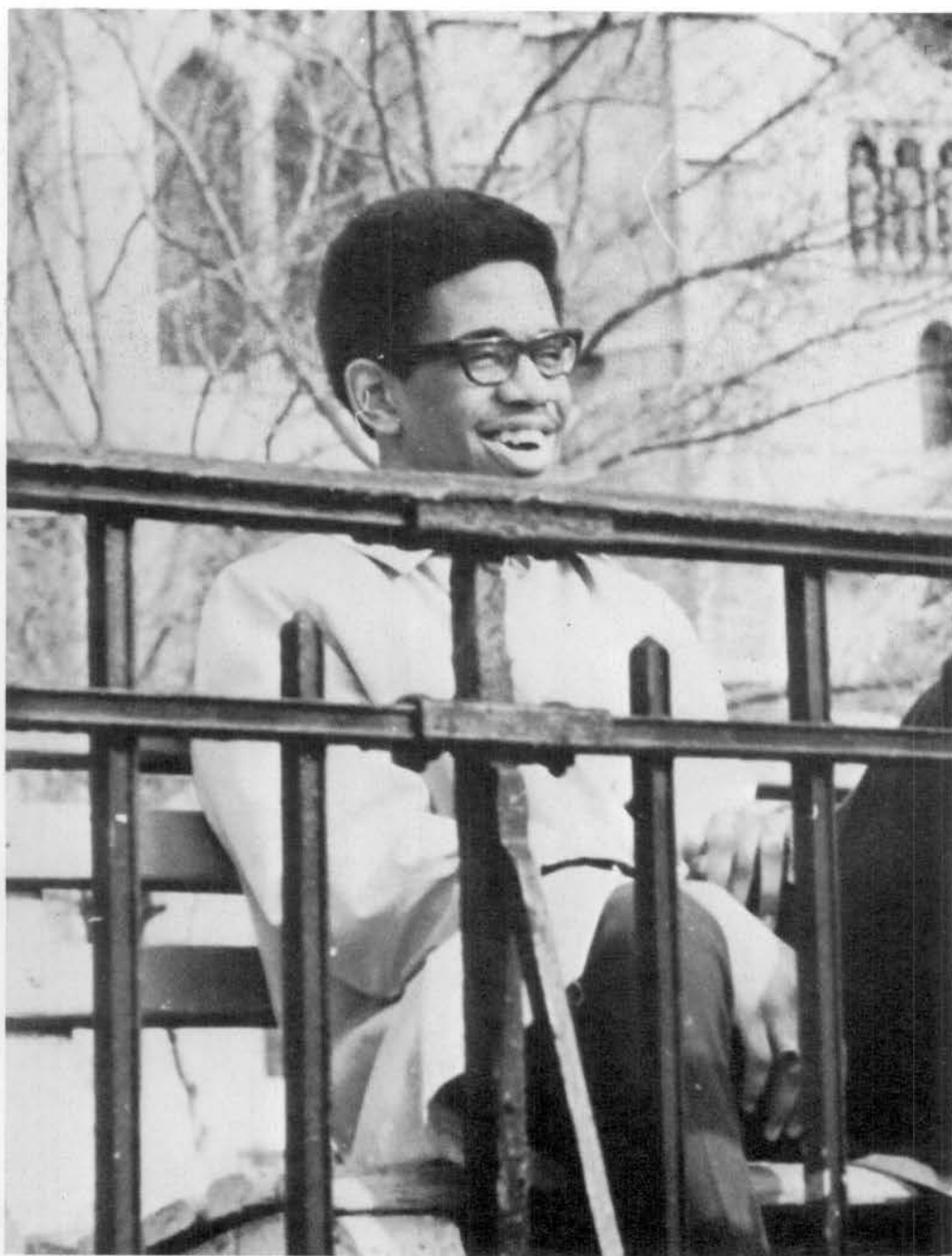

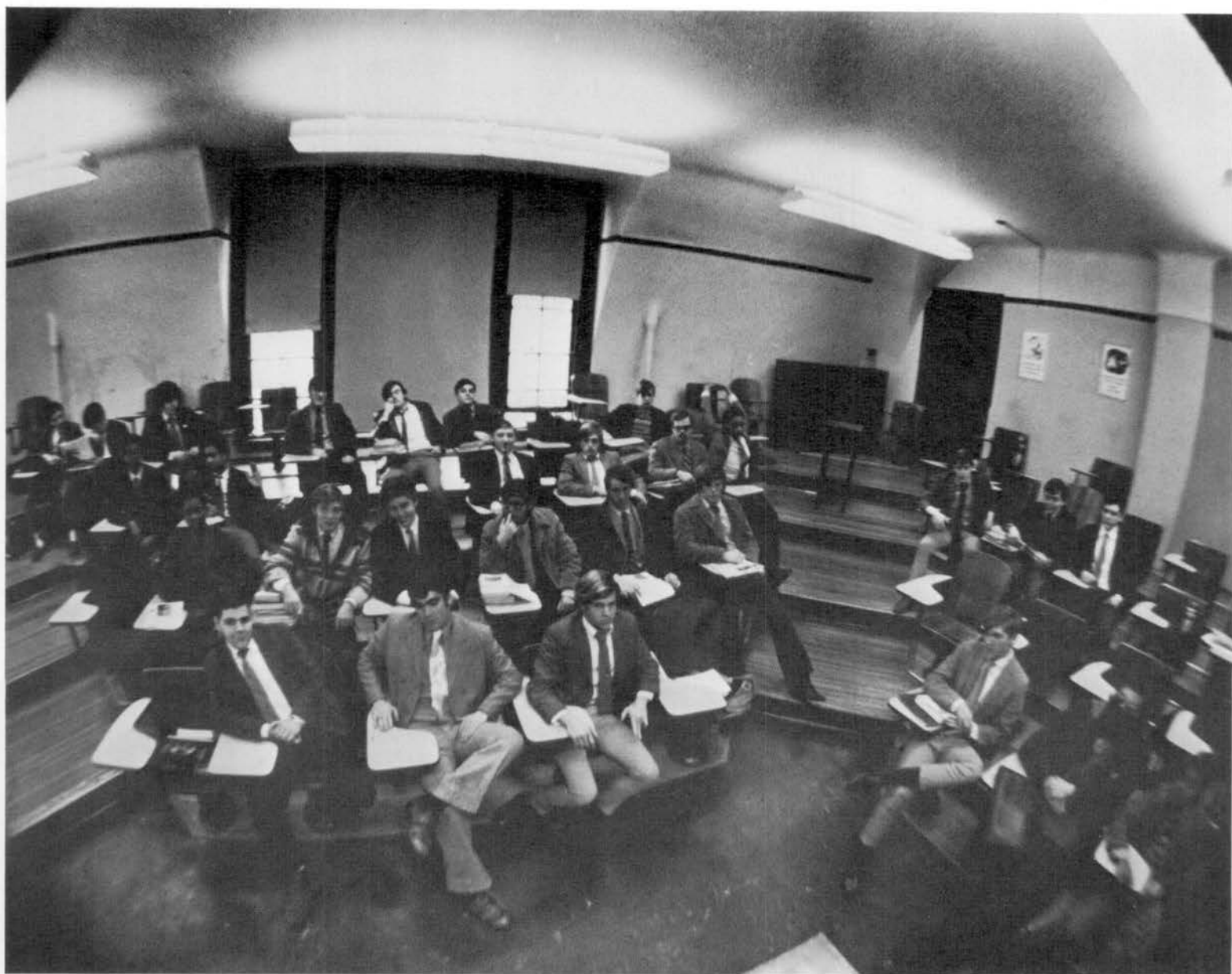




## Track

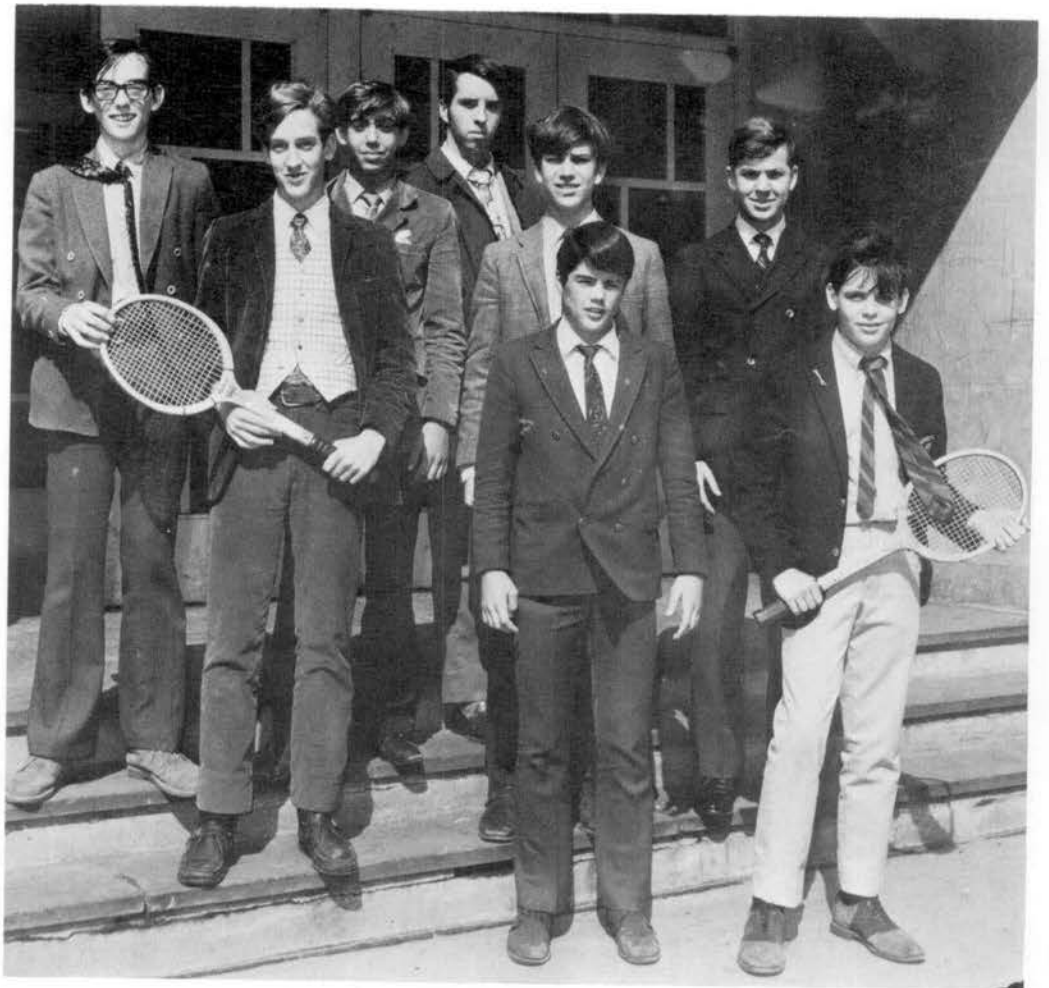
# Human Rights Workshop
