




DEDICATION

BROOKLYN PREP 6 ST. FRANCIS 12




BROOKLYN PREP 20 CARDINAL HAYES 6



BROOKLYN PREP 25 FORDHAM PREP 6


Held scoreless for two quarters by a spirited Ram team, Brooklyn Prep suddenly exploded in the second half.




We had more than able representation in the 220 yard dash with Frosh Jim McCarthy who distinguished himself among the mermen by being chosen All -Scholastic.


Because of the loss of several key players and the necessity of filling their positions with inexperienced men, this year's diamond corps has been slow in starting.


